Upon taking a walk outside, the pollution was overwhelming, as well as the noise was untenable at anytime, especially at 6:30 AM. I thought I could tolerate whatever might be happening but I no longer am able to do so. Not just this incident but others too many to list.

I want to write to you and say that the meetings and comments from the neighborhood at the last meeting were intensely opposed to the decreased set back allowances, and height maximums that are on the proposed concept plan.

I want to write to you to say that it is my strong opinion that there is very little consideration to the neighborhood concerns, stated for the present and in the future. There is a strong negative impactful disturbance to our way of life here as well as a detrimental environmental impact already. What is presented to the neighborhood does not address the strongly voiced concerns.
