Partial Certification Memo

OIG has reviewed the investigation for case number 2022OPA-0109. OIG can certify this case as thorough and objective. Although, this case cannot be certified as timely.

Under Article 3.6 (A) of the SPOG CBA, "OPA shall furnish the [named] employee and the Guild with a classification report no later than thirty (30) days after receipt of the complaint by the OPA."

In this case, the day of the complaint was 4/6/22. This date would set the deadline for the 30-day notice requirement at 5/6/22. Although the 30-day notice was not sent until 5/11/22, five days beyond the CBA requirement. This untimeliness, which according to SPOG, is taken into consideration in cases where discipline is being considered, is not certifiable by OIG.
