OIG EXP INV Partial Certification Memo

OIG has reviewed the EXP INV for case number <u>2022OPA-0221</u>. OIG can certify this case as thorough and objective. This case cannot be certified as timely.

Under Article 3.6 (A) of the SPOG CBA, "the OPA shall furnish the [named] employee and the Guild with a classification report no later than thirty (30) days after receipt of the complaint by the OPA."

In this case, the 30-day notice was due to be sent 8/20/22. It was sent 8/24/22, three business days beyond the CBA requirement. This untimeliness, which according to SPOG, is taken into consideration in cases where discipline is being considered, is not certifiable by OIG.
