OIG has reviewed the investigation for case 2025OPA-0042. The investigation is certified as thorough, timely, and objective.

OPA noted in their intake summary and body-worn video review that while driving to the call two Named Employees discussed call notes indicating the community member was alone inside the apartment. Ideally, OIG would request this detail be included in the summary of allegations against the two specific Named Employees in addition to earlier in the report, however due to the limited time OPA had to investigate this case (caused by a delayed referral) OIG is noting this as part of our certification instead of requesting changes to the report.
