MEMORIAL STADIUM Open Space Frame











- Reorganize parking for efficiency and to integrate Memorial










Memorial Wall

- Observations:
 - Memorial dominated by parking lot and hidden in parking lot
 - Memorial lacks foreground gathering area Non-operating water features

 - Limited access to memorial wall
 - Honoring the memorial









Memorial Wall

- Recognition of Landmarks Preservation status for the Memorial wall and 20' Halo
- Landmarks process and existing conditions evaluation initiated
- Initial thoughts:
 - Evaluate memorial relationship to existing stadium structure
 - Evaluate integration of a small plaza with seating
 - Evaluate water feature
 - Restore stonework





South Harrison District

- Retain and reinforce campus scale with large trees and pavilions

- Expand pedestrian area












- Expand and unify open space











South West District

- Maintain critical service access












Stadium Footprint



Approach to Sustainability

- Team ongoing evaluation: Some high points
 - 25% carbon reduction in concrete from a baseline.
 - 85-90% recycled steel.
 - Passive drainage and reuse of stormwater.
 - Complete reuse and repurpose of woody debris.
 - 15,000 to 17,000 tons of existing concrete will be turned to rubble for use as fill.
 - Stadium design will be universally accessible for patrons with disabilities.
 - The stadium will provide accommodating spaces for a wide demographic, including wellness rooms and non-gendered restrooms.
 - Ample space for separation of waste streams, including trash, recycling, and composting.
 - Mitigate heat island
 - Climate adaptive plant selection
 - High efficiency heat pump systems
 - White roofs and canopies
 - On-site EV charging of service vehicles
 - Potential for solar panel installation on roof areas
