- **Purpose:** Community Assemblies

  - Contracting with the People's Economy Lab
  - Staff will be reaching out to labor unions and community-based organizations
  - Likely have the budget for 2 assemblies, each assembly will likely consist of 3 meetings
- **Timeline:** Planning, implementation, and reporting to take place throughout 2024
- **Leads/support:** Community Engagement Committee, Board staff & interns, Board members (as they are able), People's Economy Lab & anchor organizations
- **Pilot phase:** Will evaluate whether to go forward with this engagement model going forward

  - Create a process to identify which policies to track
  - Create parameters/rubric to assess positive impact for frontline communities and opportunities to advance a GND
  - Process for sharing info and proposals with the Board and the Exec Committee, including how the PPP Comm would like to engage with the Community Engagement Comm
- 1<sup>st</sup> Lunch & Learn focused on the City's Draft Workforce Development Recommendations
