13 The City of Seattle Public Safety Civil Service Commission hereby enters the following:

14 **ORDER AND DISMISSAL**

15 An appeal was filed with the Public Safety Civil Service Commission on April 29, 2002 that was
16 subsequently referred to the Seattle Office for Civil Rights ("SOCR") for investigation based on a
17 claim of discrimination. The Final Findings of Fact and Determination was issued by SOCR on
18 April 22, 2003 that "determined that there is no reasonable cause to believe that an unfair
19 practice has been committed."

20 Whereas the Appellant has no further claims within his appeal that would be within the
21 jurisdiction of the Commission, therefore the Commission adopts the Findings of the Seattle
22 Office for Civil Rights dated April 22, 2003. This appeal is hereby dismissed with prejudice.
