1. The Public Safety Civil Service Commission's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order is not arbitrary or capricious, is not based on an error of law, and is supported by substantial evidence, and is therefore AFFIRMED.

- 2. Petitioner Seattle Police Department's request to reinstate the disciplinary decision of the Chief of Police for a 30-day suspension for all misconduct found by the Department, or in the alternative, to impose a 10-day suspension for the misconduct sustained by the Respondent Public Safety Civil Service Commission, in the matter of the misconduct of Officer Roberson is therefore DENIED.
 - Respondent Roberson's request for attorneys' fees and costs is DENIED.
- 4. Respondent Roberson's request to dismiss the writ because his counsel received a timely electronic copy of the briefing, but untimely service of a "hard copy" of the briefing the following day, is DENIED.
- Respondent Roberson's request to dismiss all misconduct findings against him based on his claim he was denied due process is DENIED.
- 6. Respondent Roberson's request that the Superior Court order the reinstatement of the difference between the seven-day suspension sustained by the Public Safety Civil Service Commission and the 30-day suspension imposed by the Department is not properly before the Court and is therefore DENIED.
