DISMISSAL ORDER

9 The hearing in this matter was scheduled to commence at 9:00 a.m., June 27, 2023, and
10 continue to June 28, 2023, pursuant to the Amended Notice of Hearing, issued June 2, 2023. The
11 Public Safety Civil Service Commission ("Commission") opened the hearing and noted for the
12 record that the Appellant had not appeared in person or remotely by 10:00 a.m. Despite the
13 Commission's many attempts to contact the Appellant using text message, telephone calls, voice
14 message, and email, he did not appear or communicate with the Commission on June 27, 2023.

15 At 1:00 p.m., June 27, 2023, the Commission reconvened the hearing on the record, noting
16 that it still had not had contact from the Appellant, although the hearing was scheduled to begin at
17 9:00 a.m. on June 27, 2023. The Respondent moved to dismiss the appeal. The Commission
18 unanimously agreed to dismiss the appeal, with no Commissioner objecting to granting the motion.

19 **ORDER**

20 It is hereby ordered that the appeal in this matter is dismissed, based on the Appellant's
21 failure to appear or contact the Commission regarding his non-appearance for the hearing.
