RESOLUTION 59

A RESOLUTION relating to the 2023 Seattle Park District Budget, carrying forward non-capital appropriation from the 2022 Seattle Park District Budget.

WHEREAS, in accordance with RCW 35.61.040, formation of the Seattle Park District became effective and its boundaries established as of August 19, 2014, upon certification of results of the August 5, 2014, election; and

WHEREAS, the 2022 Adopted Park District Budget appropriated \$56,035,590 in total operating and capital funds, \$34,868,901 of which is appropriated to fund Park District operating initiatives (Resolution 44); and

WHEREAS, appropriations provided in the Park District budget for operating and maintenance expenses that remain unexpended or unencumbered at the close of the fiscal year shall automatically lapse unless otherwise authorized by the Park District Board of Commissioners via resolution; and

WHEREAS, Seattle Parks and Recreation and the Seattle Park District did not fully spend certain funds appropriated in the 2022 Adopted Budget; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE SEATTLE PARK DISTRICT, KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Of the total \$34,868,901 appropriated in 2022 to fund Park District operating initiatives, \$700,000 of unspent funds so appropriated will carry forward to the subsequent fiscal year operating budget.
