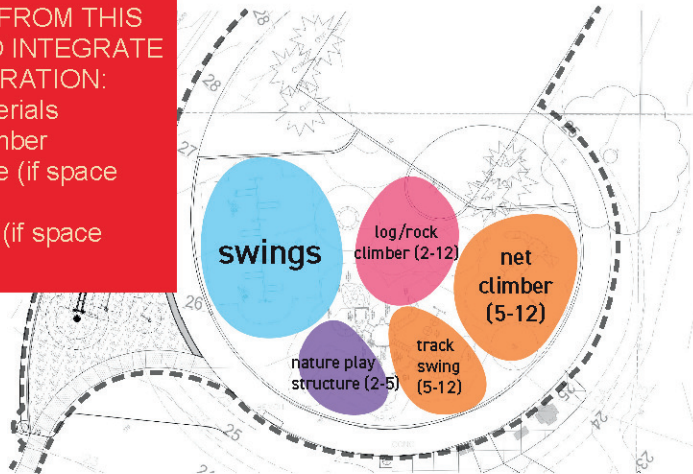
## nature adventure

- track swing (if space allows)



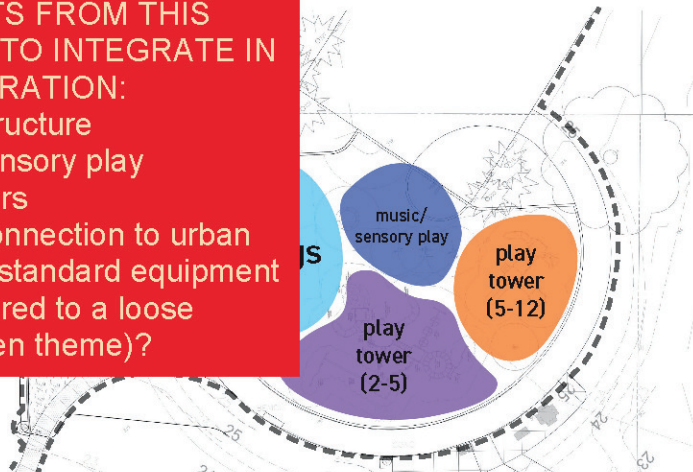
## garden theme

Play amongst giant flowers and insects in this garden-themed play area! Bright colors, music play, and whimsical play structures set this scheme apart.



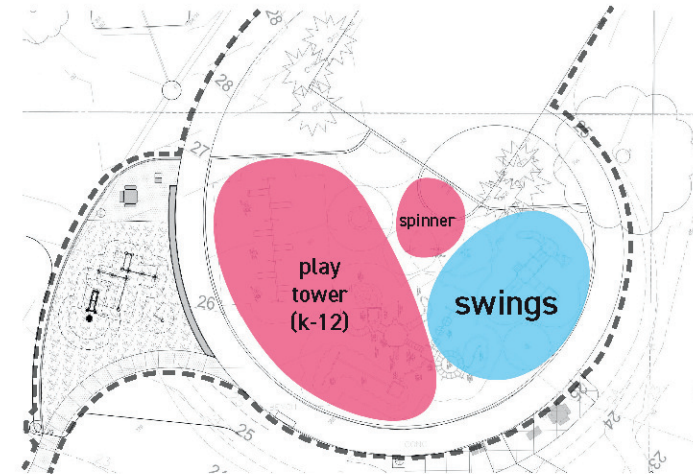
ELEMENTS FROM THIS SCHEME TO INTEGRATE IN NEXT ITERATION:

Play is for everyone! While all the play schemes will have accessible play elements, this scheme prioritizes inclusivity with a fully-accessible play tower, spinner, swings, and sensory play.

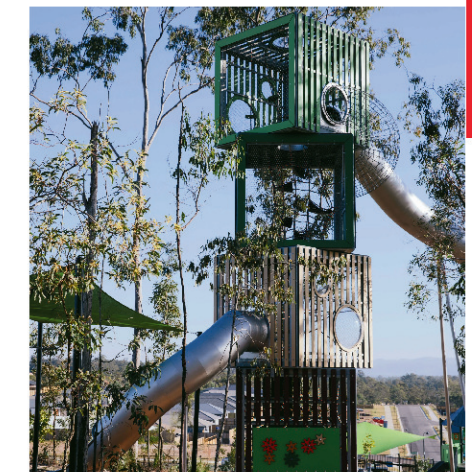


ELEMENTS FROM THIS SCHEME TO INTEGRATE IN NEXT ITERATION:
