

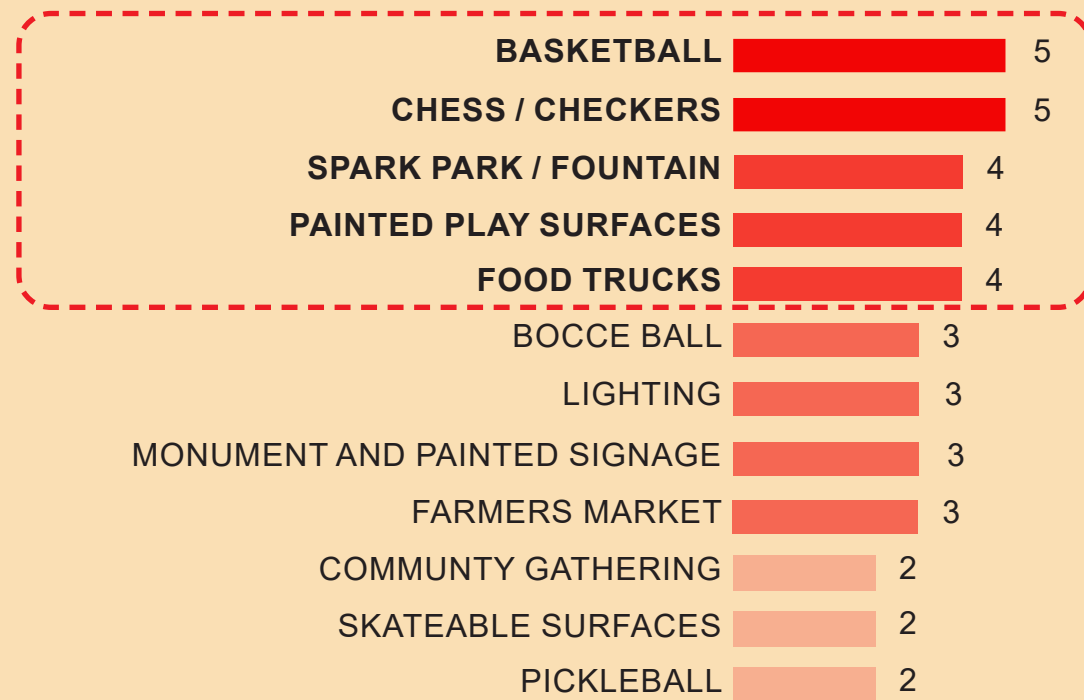
32ND AVE ROW DESIGN

"Keep as much shade and trees as possible"

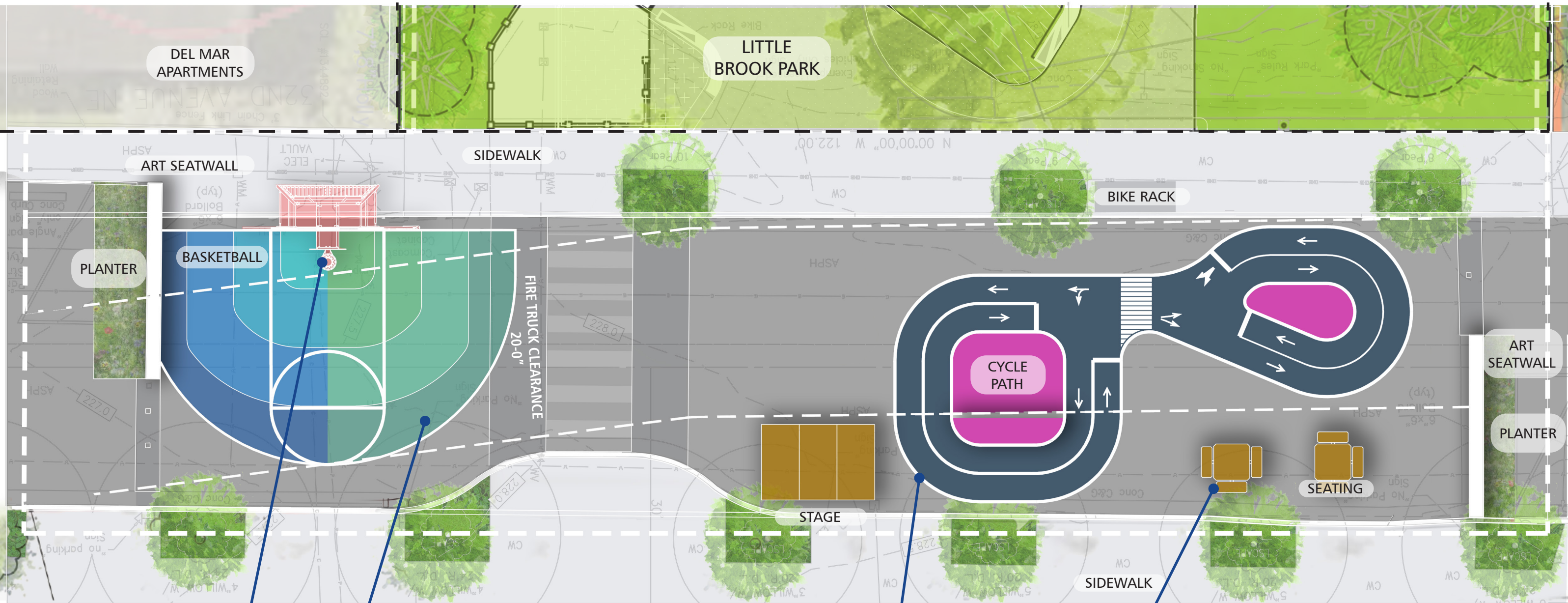
"More picnic tables! Bigger tables and benches. ."

"Spray park, more like a sculpture piece with water."

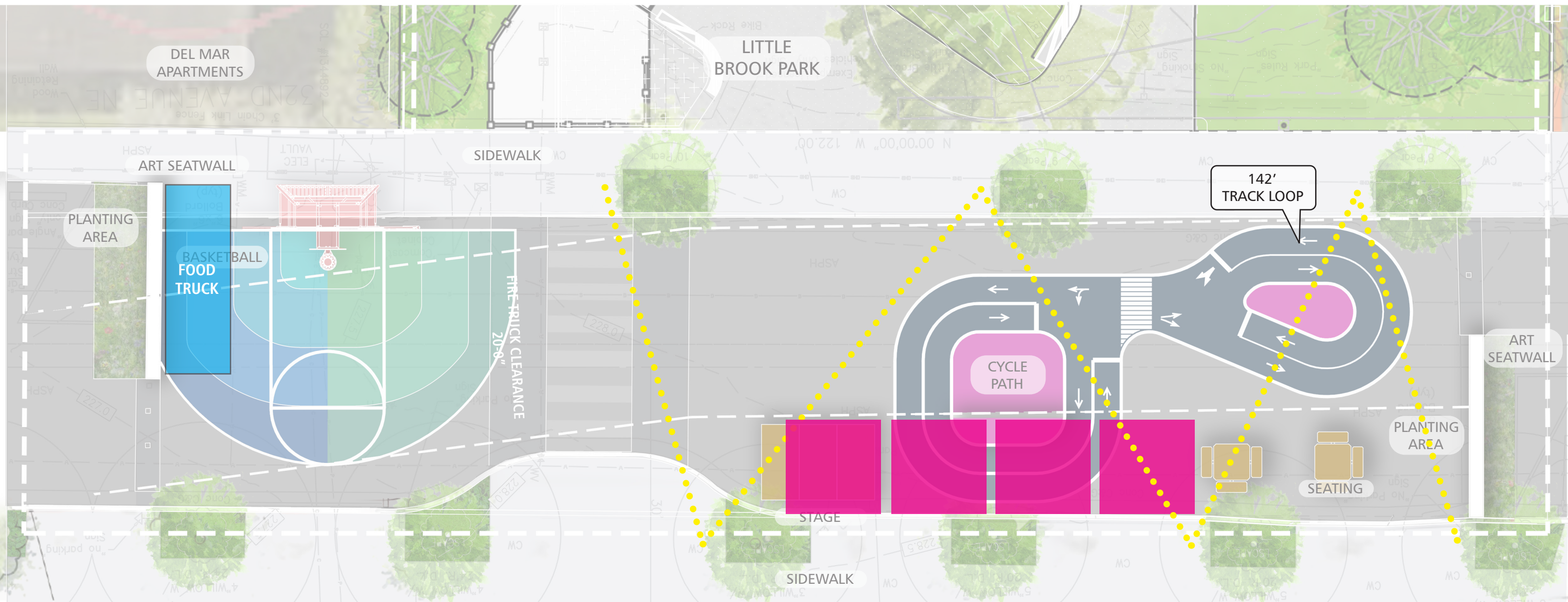
DESIGN GOALS

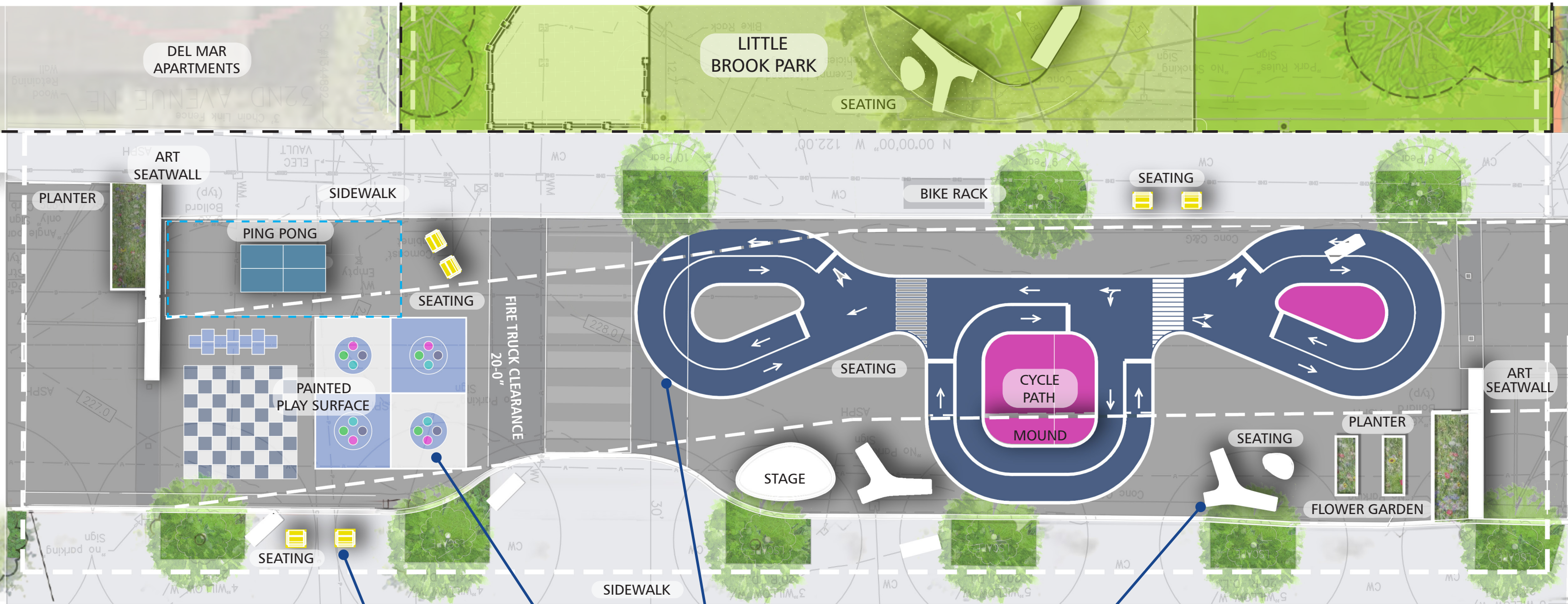


OPTION A: FRONT YARD - EVENT LAYOUT

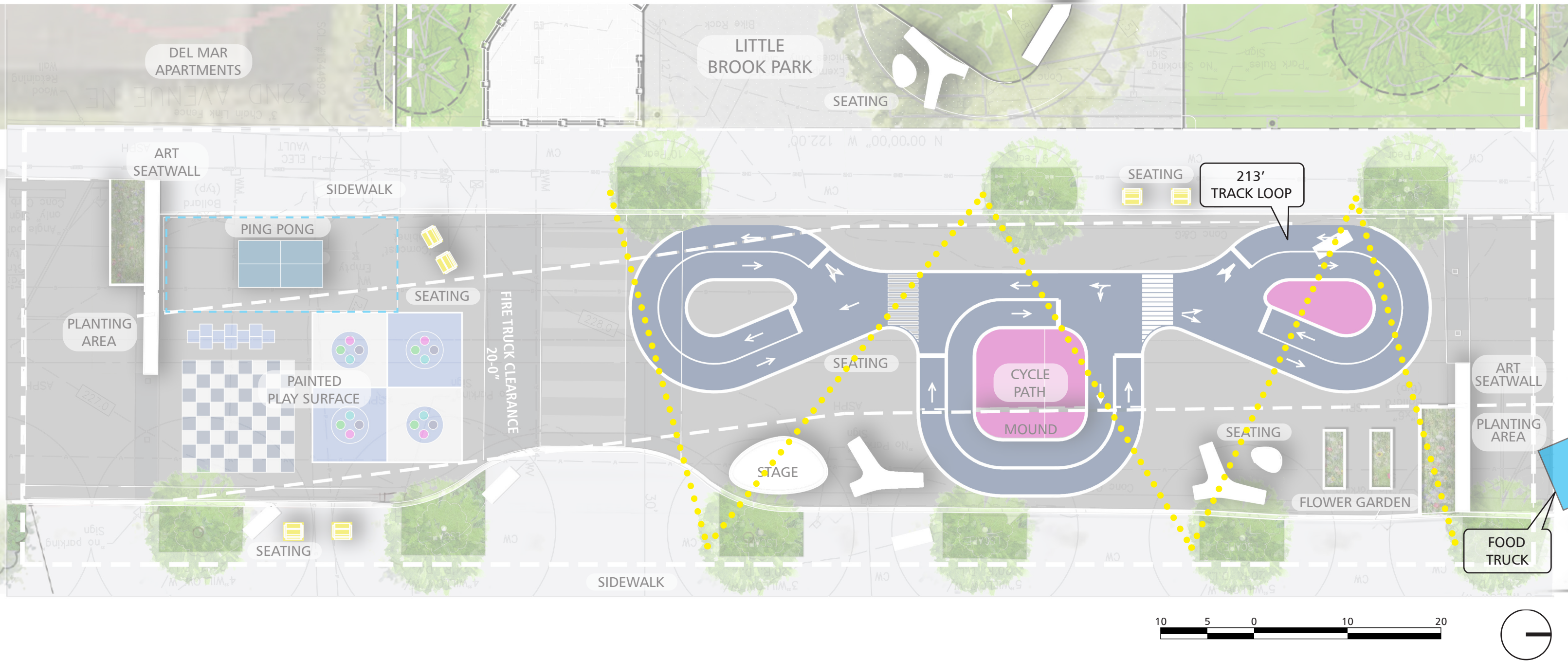

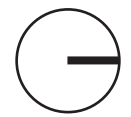
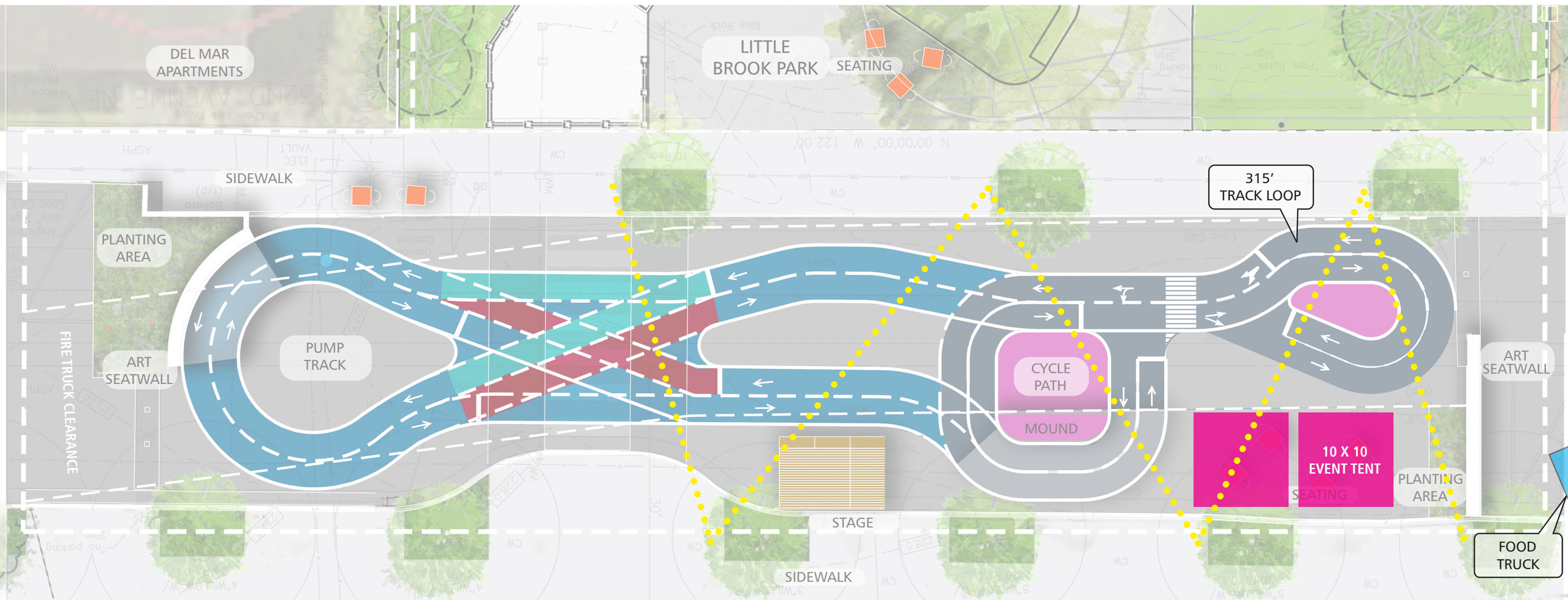
OPTION B: PLAZA - EVENT LAYOUT
