SUBJECT: Bias Crimes and Bias Incidents Synopsis - (1st Half 2017 dates 01/01/17-06/30/17)

Overview

During the first half of 2017, **178** criminal and non-criminal bias based incidents were reported to the Seattle Police Department. This compares to **128** bias based incidents reported in the first half of 2016. This reflects a 39% increase of bias based incidents, city-wide.

Malicious harassment cases increased by **22%**, the category of **crimes with bias elements** rose **64%**, and **non-criminal bias incidents** rose **33%**, respectively from the same period of time in 2016.

Reported **anti-LGBTQ** malicious harassment cases numbered 19 during the first half of 2016, and increased to 25 during the first half of 2017.

Reported **anti-Black** malicious harassment cases numbered 16 during the first half of 2016, and decreased to 12 during the first half of 2017. Reported anti-Black crimes with bias elements increased from 6 reported incidents during the first half of 2016 to 23 during the first half of 2017.

The majority of reported incidents occurred during **second watch hours**, followed by **third** and **first watches**.

West Precinct had the most incidents, accounting for 31% of the total number city wide, followed by **North Precinct** at 30% and **East Precinct** at 21%. **South Precinct** reported 11% of the incidents, followed by **Southwest Precinct** at 7%.

Incidents

- ✓ 61 were determined to be Malicious Harassment
- ✓ 69 of the incidents were determined to be crimes with bias elements
- ✓ 48 of the incidents were determined to be non-criminal bias incidents

Arrests

- ✓ 18 total cases resulted in an arrest in 61 Malicious Harassment crimes:
 - 12 were arrested and/or charged with a felony crime
 - 6 were arrested and/or charged with a misdemeanor offense
 - 2 cases were cleared exceptional- the victim did not want to press charges
 - 28 cases were inactivated or administratively cleared due to solvability or other factors
 - 13 cases remain open and under investigation

33 total cases resulted in an arrest out of 69 crimes with bias elements

- 9 were arrested and/or charged with a felony crime
- 24 were arrested and/or charged with a misdemeanor offense
- 36 cases were inactivated or administratively cleared due to solvability or other factors

Bias Categories

The bias events targeted eighteen total groups with the two most frequent groups, anti-black and anti-gay/lesbian accounting for 49% of the total bias based incidents.

*Three incidents included bias elements in more than one category. The total number of discrete incidents was 178. Categories in which no incidents were reported were not included in this table.

- The category of Anti-Black represents 25% of the total reported incidents.
- The category of Anti-Gay and Lesbian represents 24% percent of the incidents.
- **26.4%** of the criminal and non-criminal bias incidents occurred during 1st watch hours (0300-1159)
- **39.3%** of the criminal and non-criminal bias incidents occurred during 2nd watch hours (1200-1959)
- **34.3%** of the criminal and non-criminal bias incidents occurred during 3rd watch hours (2000-0259)

David Sector represents **12%** of the total crimes and **33 %** of the non-criminal bias incidents in the West Precinct.

King Sector **37%** of the total crimes and **42%** of the non-criminal bias incidents in the West Precinct.

Mary Sector represents **35%** of the total crimes and **25%** of the non-criminal bias incidents in the West Precinct.

Queen Sector represents **16%** of the total crimes and **0%** of the non-criminal bias incidents in the West Precinct.

Sam Sector represents 39% of the crimes and 33% of the non-criminal bias incidents in the South Precinct.

Ocean Sector represents 23% of the total crimes and 0% of the non-criminal bias incidents in the South Precinct.

Lincoln Sector represents 26% of the total crimes and 20% of the non-criminal bias incidents in the North Precinct.

John Sector represents 15% of the total crimes and 13.3% of the non-criminal bias incidents in the North Precinct.
