 Public comment period allows individuals to inform and advise the Commission about issues, problems, or concerns.

- Register to attend through the Zoom link provided for the meeting.
- During the meeting, the Chair will ask the public to use the Raise Hand function to be added to the public comment list. To use the Raise Hand function:
 - Online/Desktop App Users
 - Click the Participants button that sits at the bottom right corner of the window
 - Click on the hand icon that sits at the bottom of the menu next to the Share function
 - Click Raise hand in the webinar controls. The host will be notified that you've raised your hand.
 - Windows: You can also use the Alt+Y keyboard shortcut to raise or lower your hand.
 - Mac: You can also use the Option+Y keyboard shortcut to raise or lower your hand.
 - Mobile App Users
 - Click the Participants button that sits at the top right corner of the window
 - Click Raise Hand that sits at the bottom right corner of the Participants List
 - Call-in Users
 - Press *3 to raise your hand
- Once called upon, you will be unmuted with a limit of 2 minutes to speak.
- Provide clear and concise comments.
- Avoid repeating comments already expressed by others.
- After speaking, Lower Hand by using the method to Raise Hand.
