**Attention Renters!** 

When the eviction moratorium expires.....

Do you know about Seattle's additional eviction protections?



- **Covid-related inability to pay:** limits eviction of tenants with delinquent rent accrued between March 3, 2020 and up to 6 months after the end of the moratorium/civil emergency
- **Winter eviction protection:** limits eviction from December 1- March 1 for income-qualified tenants
- School year eviction protection: limits eviction from September to June for households with students (childcare – under 18), educators, and employees of schools
