Georgetown Off-Leash Dog Area

Construction begins October 27

PROJECT OVERVIEW

On October 27, construction will begin at the open space between the Aero Motel and Boeing Campus. The project will build a new off-leash dog park and off-street walking and biking connection. When construction is complete, the new park will provide an acre of green space, 80 new trees, and a safe and accessible connection for people walking and biking between Georgetown and South Park.

PROJECT TIMELINE

Start of construction: Fall 2025

- Fall 2025: Project setup, survey, tree removals, soil removal and replacement.
- Winter 2025: Underground utility work, constructing the multi-use trail.
- Spring 2025: Tree planting, installing lighting, finishing work.

End of construction: Summer 2026

*Dates are based on current schedule. Many construction activities are weather-dependent and subject to change.

WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT

During construction, you can expect the following:

- Typical work hours are from Monday to Friday, starting at 7:00 A.M. and finishing at 5:00 P.M.
- The project area will be closed to the public during construction.
- Please expect parking and access changes on S Myrtle St through construction as our crews use the street for access and equipment storage.
- During excavation work, crews will water and cover work areas to mitigate dust.
- Some of the work activities might be noisy. This includes using backup alarms for safety, heavy vehicles, and power tools.

PROJECT & SITE HISTORY

The project site contains contaminated soil due to industrial activities in early to mid-1900s. The project conducted environmental review in 2021-2023 to ensure we could safely remove this contaminated soil without harming people and the environment. The first month or more of construction will prioritize removing this contaminated soil and replacing it with clean material.
