Sound Transit - Future Ready, At-Grade Crossing Safety, Fare Compliance

- Future Ready
 - o Platforms in the Rainier valley new tiles with better attachment for better future maintenance
 - 10 min frequency between stadium and NG and 20 minutes between NG and Angle Lake only every train will go all the way through during Columbia City project.
 - Othello and Rainier beach both need similar repair before opening of East Link
 - Both stations can be done at one; should allow trains to operate more often than 20 minutes
 - Overhead wire sectioning in downtown tunnel
 - Need to close down all downtain stations when any work needs to be done because overhead wires are connected.
 - Project will split overhead wires at University street, reducing the number of stations that need to close during future maintenance
 - Tukwila Overhead wire replacement between Boeing Access rd and Tukwila Int'l.
 - Likely will have bus bridging between Rainier Beach and Tukwila
 - Other Projects:
 - Rail replacement near Westlake
 - Bond box replacement
 - East Link prep work
- At-Grade Crossing Safety
 - o Internal work group first area of focus in Rainier Valley
 - Partnered with SDOT to add railroad-grade crossing markings; no left turn warning signs, and update another train coming signs
 - Community feedback, including increasing volume of warnings.
 - Next steps traffic studies, engagement
- Fare Compliance
 - Board approved funding for ambassador staff
 - Reduced ORCA lift fares, focus on increasing enrollment goal of 80% ORCA Lift riders in the region enrolled
 - Updated policies:
 - Increased # of warnings before fines
 - Approved ability to implement alternative resolution program
 - Removed collections
