

# THORNTON CREEK BRIDGE STUDY

FACT SHEET

## **PROJECT OVERVIEW**

The Thornton Creek Bridge Study will explore rehabilitation and replacement options for 4 bridges in northeast Seattle. The bridges each carry thousands of vehicles per day across the Thornton Creek channel and are, on average, over 65 years old.

All bridges in the city are continually maintained for public safety and periodically monitored. While still safe to use, these 4 bridges are showing signs of deterioration and have been determined to be near the end of their useful life-cycle.

The primary goal of this planning study is to identify feasible solutions that address long-term multimodal transportation demand. The study is being conducted as part of the 9-year Levy to Move Seattle approved by Seattle voters in 2015.

#### **PROJECT AREAS**

The four bridges in the study are:

- Bridge No. 104: NE 105th St at 40th Ave NE
- Bridge No.105: NE 110th St, west of 36th Ave NE
- Bridge No. 109:
  45th Ave NE, just south of NE 97th St
- Bridge No. 115: 39th Ave NE, just north of NE 105th St

## WHAT'S HAPPENING NOW?

We will be exploring soil conditions at each bridge. You can expect to see equipment, crew members, and City of Seattle staff. The work requires a hole to be drilled at each site. Flaggers will control traffic. Upon completion holes will be filled and the surface restored to its original condition.


