PROJECT OVERVIEW

We've been working over the past few years to improve transportation safety in the Licton Springs neighborhood to make it easier for kids to walk and bike to the new school campus.

In addition to the new Aurora Ave N signal, neighborhood greenways, and other traffic calming improvements we've already installed, we'll add more speed humps, new crossing beacons, and restrict parking to make crosswalks more visible over the next year.

New crosswalks with flashing beacons will be installed at: Stone Ave N and N 90th St, Interlake Ave N and N 90th St, and Densmore Ave N and N 90th St. We will also paint curbs and add signs to prohibit parking at the new crosswalks to improve visibility.
