

30th Ave NE Sidewalk & Natural Drainage System

Full corridor work July 27 - August 10

FULL CORRIDOR WORK NEXT TWO WEEKS

Crews are working to install a new sidewalk and natural drainage system (NDS) along the east side of 30th Ave NE from NE 130th St to NE 137th St.

Over the next two weeks, crews will be completing construction work to get ready for sidewalk and NDS installation. Work will involve loud construction noise, dust, and vibration, Monday to Friday, 7 AM to 4 PM.

Here's what to expect:

Friday, July 27: Crews will begin sawcutting along the east side of 30th from 130th to 137th. This work will be complete Monday, July 30.

Monday, July 30: Crews will perform potholing work along the east side of 30th from 130th to 137th. This work is expected to last one week.

Monday, August 6: Crews will begin to clear all vegetation from work areas, and install drainage. Work will begin at 130th and proceed north.

PROJECT OVERVIEW

This project will make it safer, easier, and more pleasant to walk along 30th Ave. Additionally, the NDS will capture and treat large volumes of polluted stormwater that flow into Thornton Creek when it rains. The project is the first step in completing a series of sidewalks on 30th Ave NE (see map on back).

Construction is expected to last through the end of the year and is weather dependent.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Typical work hours: 7 AM 4 PM, Monday - Friday
- Crews plan to construct sidewalks from between NE 130th St to NE 137th St
- Construction noise, dust, and vibration
- Access to businesses and homes will be maintained at all times
- Traffic maintained in all directions, but may be reduced to one lane at times
- Temporary parking restrictions
- Temporary driveway restrictions. We'll notify you individually if you'll be impacted
- Temporary pedestrian and bike detours around the work zone and staging area
- Transit routes should run according to their regular schedules; visit King County Metro's website for more information about your route: metro.kingcounty.gov
- Mail and garbage will be delivered and picked up as normal.
