Project Description

SDOT, in partnership with King County Metro, has begun working on a new design vision for Aurora Ave. This is a joint long-range planning study that will, with input from impacted stakeholders and members of the community, inform the scope and vision of the project. This project seeks to:

- Enhance comfort and access for people walking, biking, and taking transit along the corridor
- Reduce collisions for all users
- Improve accessibility and safety

Project Benefits

- Develop a design vision that enhances safety, mobility, and accessibility for all travelers
- Identifies transit service improvement and connection needs
- Addresses the needs of residents, businesses, and corridor stakeholders


Schedule

- **Summer/Fall 2022:** Launch survey #1 to understand key concerns
- **Winter 2023:** Design and planning phase, develop alternatives
- **Summer 2023:** Launch survey #2 to receive feedback on design alternatives
- **Fall 2023:** Share outcome

Project Area Map

Due to the length of Aurora Ave, and to accommodate different access needs, SDOT plans to divide the corridor into these five segments:

- Harrison St to N 38th St
- N 38th St to Winona Ave N
- Winona Ave N to N 85th St
- N 85th St to N 115th St
- N 115th St to N 145th St
