Project Survey

Funding

The SDOT Home Zone team collaborated with other Departments and Programs to get additional funds for projects. The following partnerships are reflected on the DRAFT Home Zone:

Your Voice Your Choice Program:

- \$35,000 for speed cushions on Holly Park Dr. S

Private Development:

- \$25,000 for Decorative Crosswalks

Department of Neighborhood, Neighborhood Matching Fund:

- Youth led art for crosswalks, youth led mural

Neighborhood Greenway Program:

- \$300,000 for the Neighborhood Greenway and/or Stay Healthy Street. Design and outreach for this project is expected to occur in 2023 and implementation in 2024.

Pedestrian Master Plan Program:

- \$50,000 for curb ramps and crossing improvements

Grant Requests:

- \$4M for Chief Sealth Trail Connections
- \$100k for pedestrian crossing improvements on S Mytle St.
- \$500,000 requested for asphalt pathways connecting the community to the Chief Sealth Trail.

Collaboration

Working together, SDOT and Hosted (Healthy Othello Safer Through Environmental Design) joined four community walks. During the walks we received concerns, issues, and thoughts from the community. We reviewed the community feedback through a series of meetings with the New Holly/Othello Home Zone Steering Committee. Together, we developed projects in response to community concerns. These projects resulted in the DRAFT New Holly/Othello Home Zone.

Home Zone Funding

There is \$200,000 in the Home Zone Program to fund the following projects:

1. Five Intersection Improvements: \$50,000
2. Traffic Calmed Route: \$100,000 for speed humps and signage
3. Speed Humps: \$50,000 for speed humps along 32nd Ave S
4. Conceptual Designs Only
 - a. Chief Trail Connection: \$20,000 for concept design and to help SDOT apply for future grants
 - b. Walkway Improvements: \$10,000 for concept design along S Holly St
 - c. Intersection Improvements: \$10,000 for concept design at S Morgan St and 31st Ave S
