





## **Traffic Data Collection**

- Collected speed and volume data at 10 locations throughout the neighborhood
- Tube count method over 7-day period
- Two different weeks of data collection
  - February 4<sup>th</sup> February 10<sup>th</sup>
  - March 8<sup>th</sup> March 14<sup>th</sup>


