











## **Draft Home Zone Process**

  - **NE 143<sup>rd</sup> St** between 15<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> Aves
  - NE 135<sup>th</sup> St between 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> Aves
  - NE 130<sup>th</sup> St between 27<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> Aves
  - NE Brockman Pl between 15<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>
    Aves
  - 17<sup>th</sup> Ave NE between NE 125<sup>th</sup> St and NE Brockman Pl
  - 20<sup>th</sup> Ave NE between NE 143<sup>rd</sup> and NE 145<sup>th</sup> Sts
  - 23<sup>rd</sup> Ave NE between NE 130<sup>th</sup> and NE 133<sup>rd</sup> Sts
























