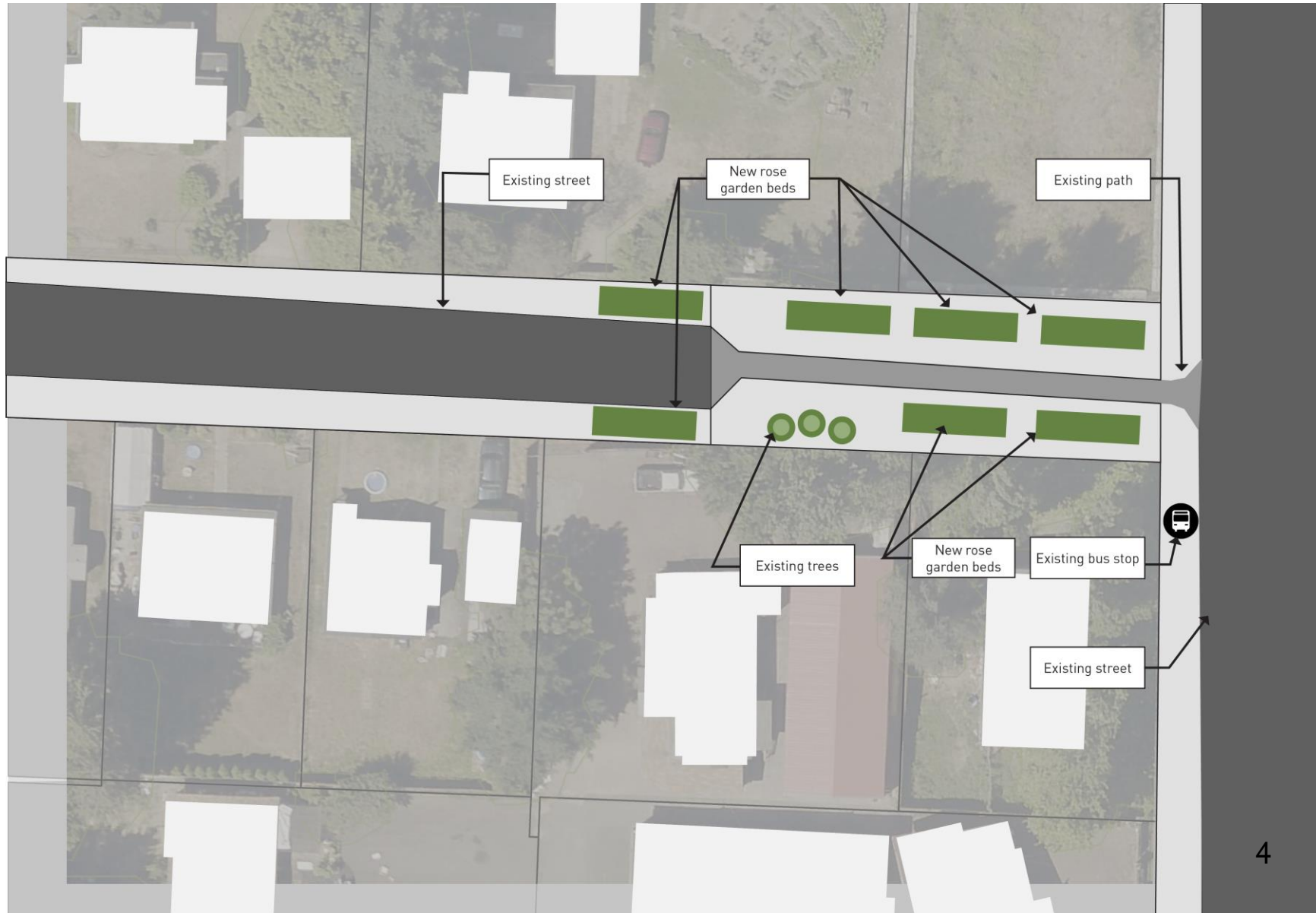

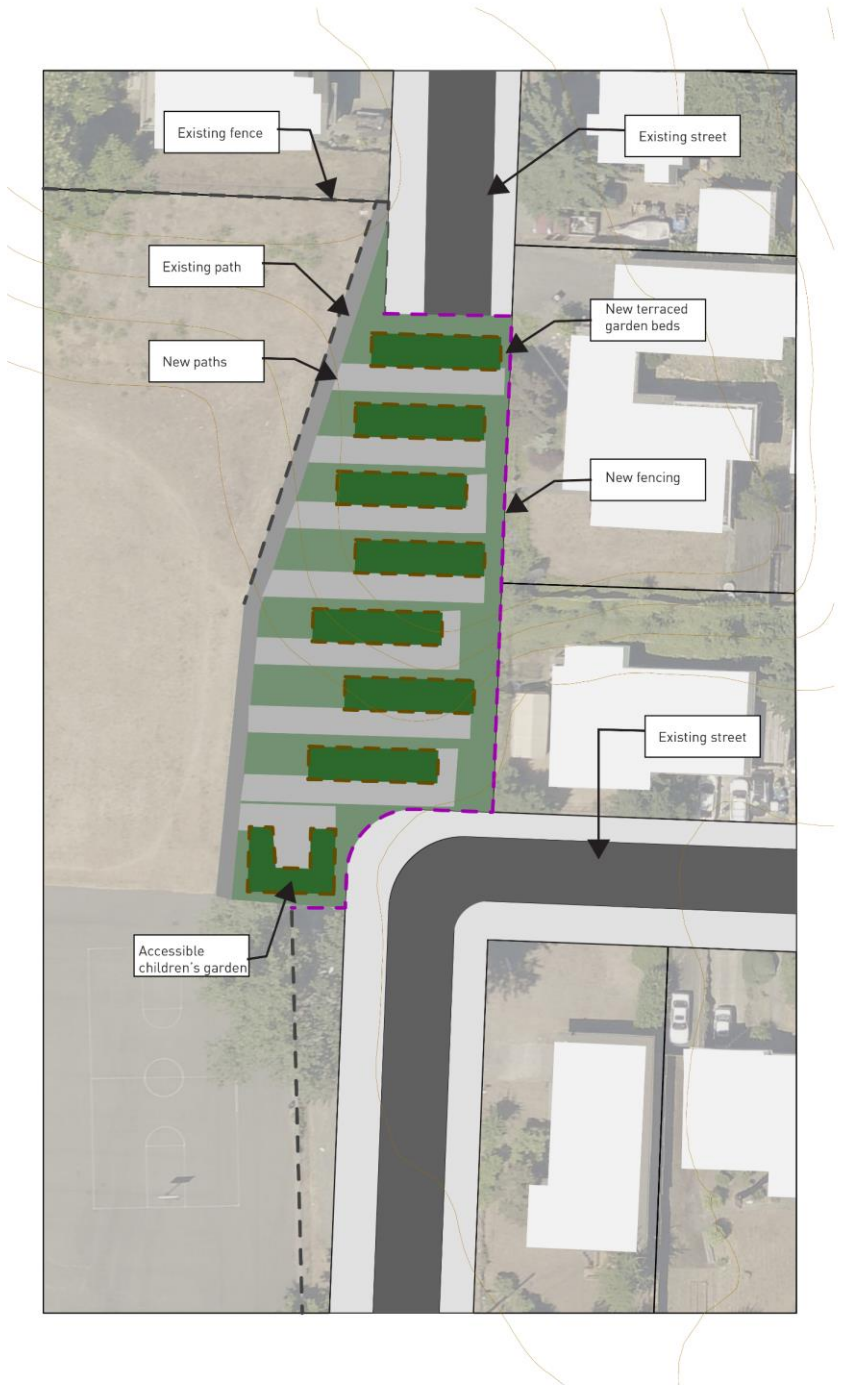
# Environmental Justice Fund (OSE)

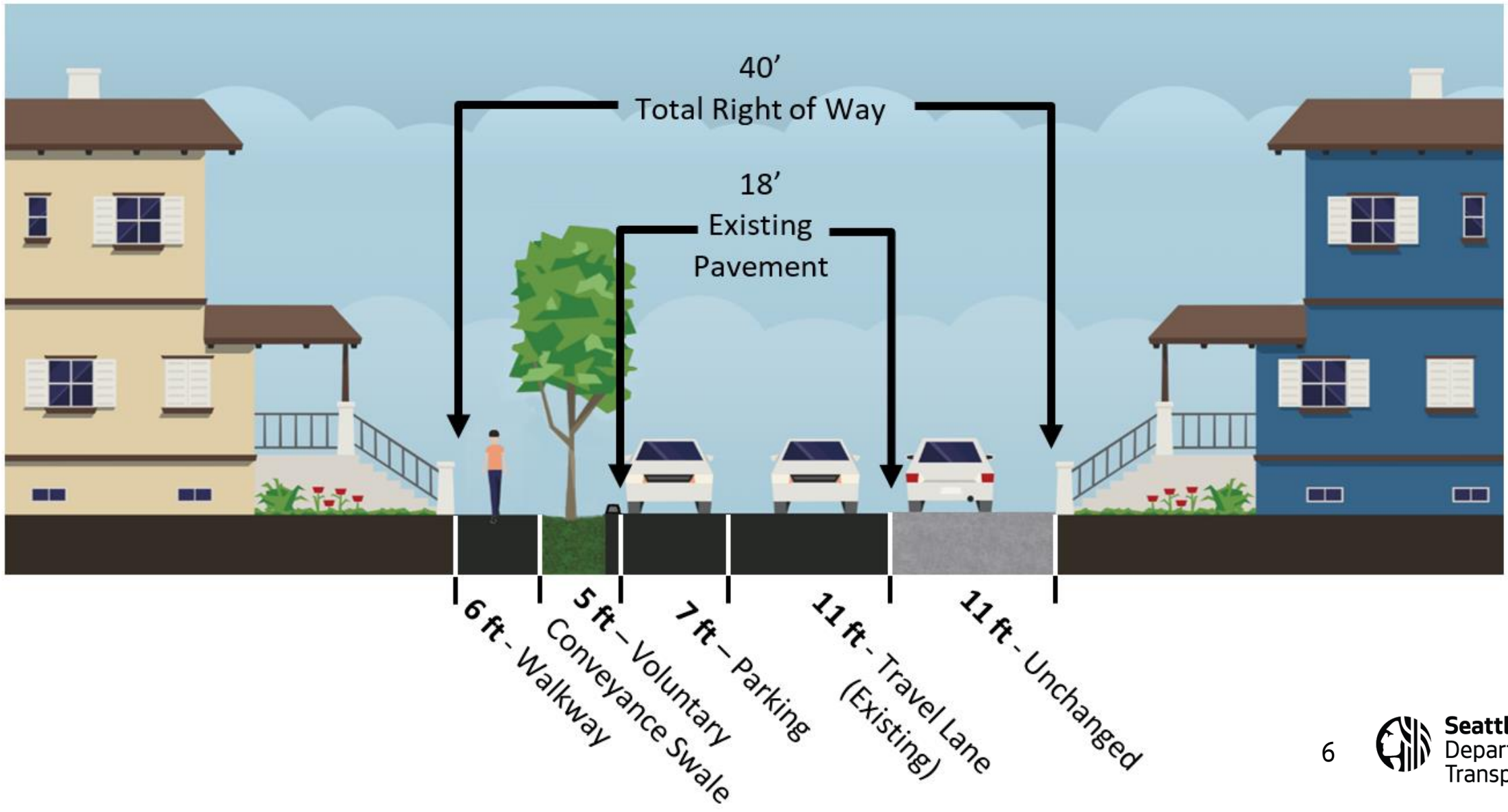

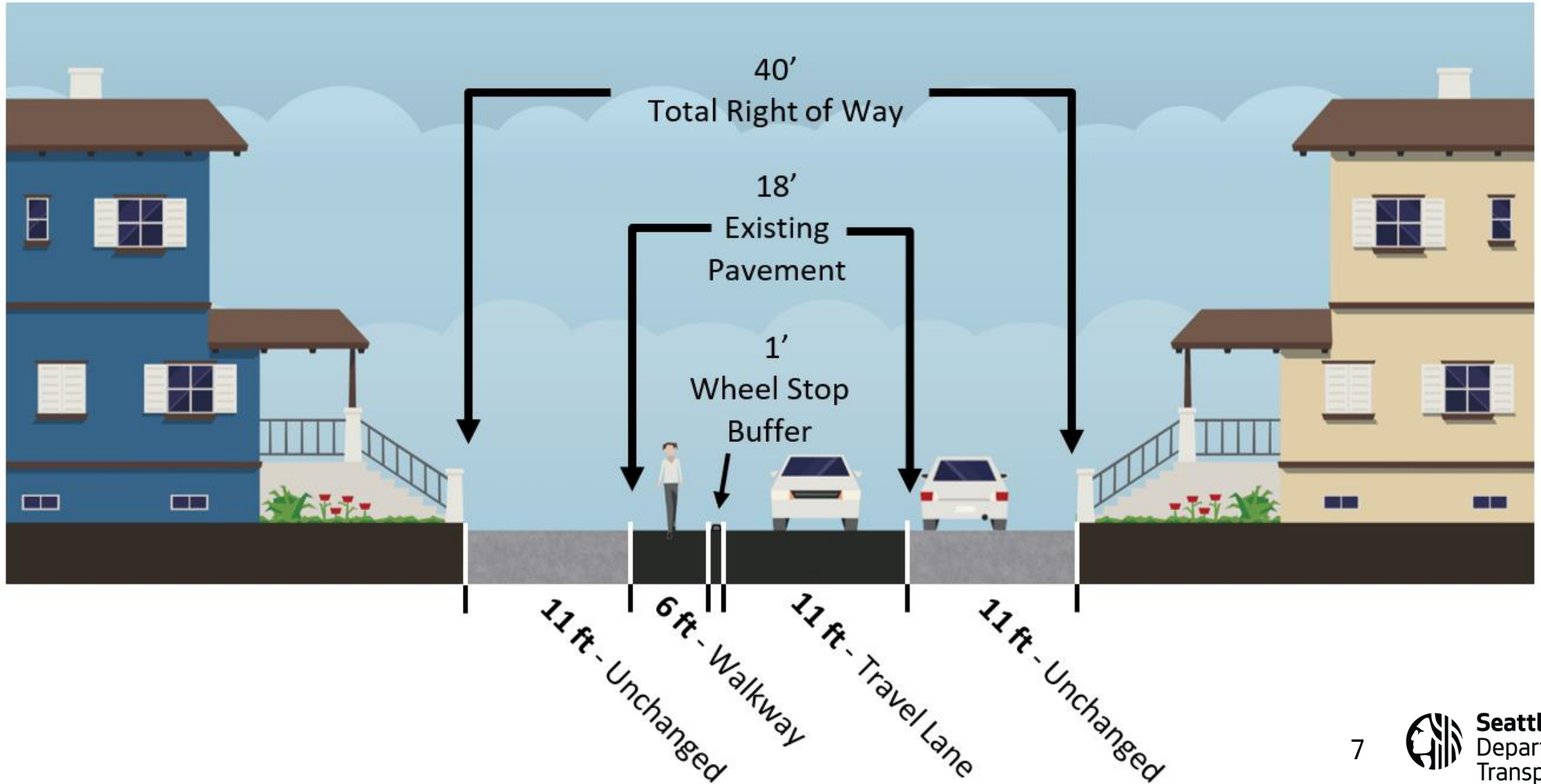




# Cross-Section: Alternative Walkway



# Cross-Section: Dedicated Pedestrian Space

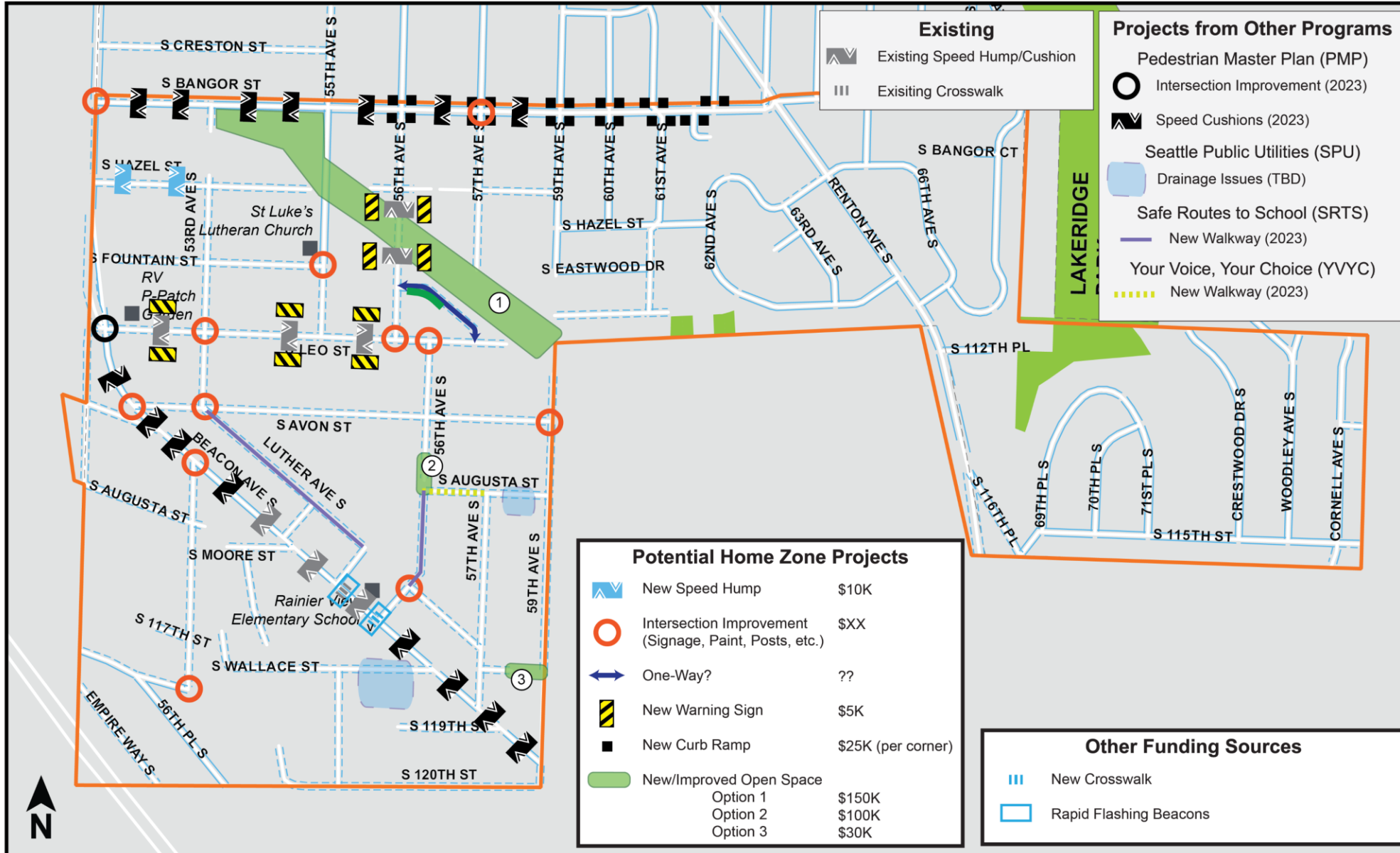


# Next Steps

# Rainier View Draft Home Zone (4) - Do Not Share Outside of Steering Committee



## Changes:

- Moved walkways to their own map (under development)
- Rearranged legends to clarify which items need home zone input and which are projects from other programs
- Split speed hump and speed cushion projects for clarity
- Corrected shape of Open Space # 1
