

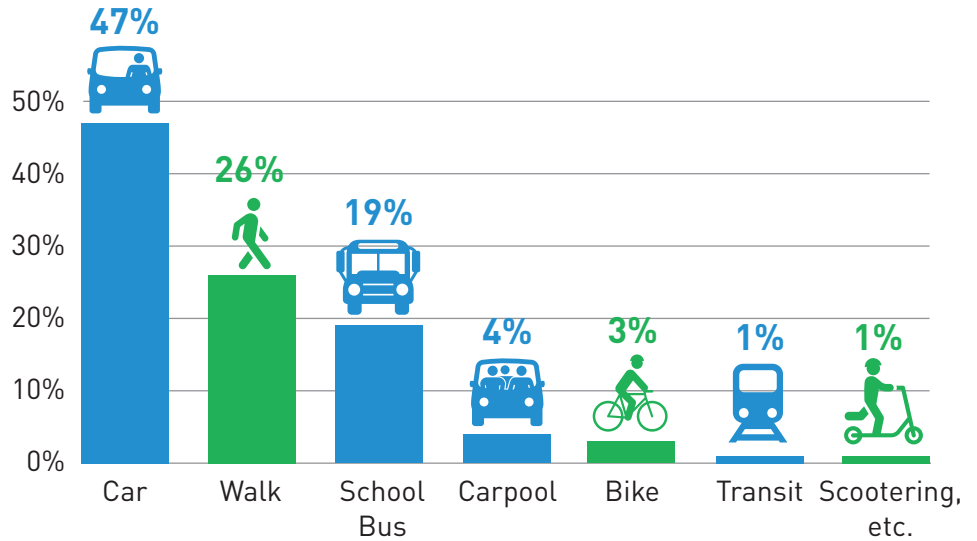


GETTING TO SCHOOL IN 2023

In June of 2023, a record number of **54 schools** participated in this survey.



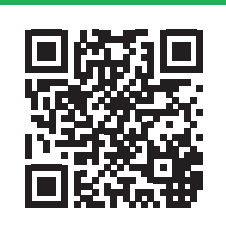

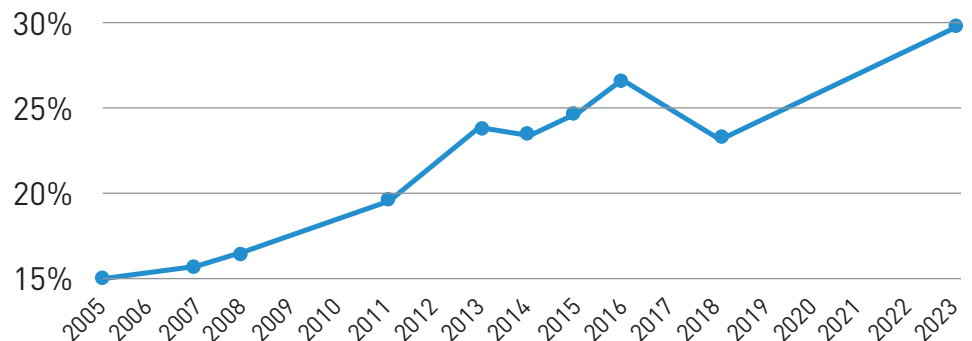

Walking, biking, and scootering to school has doubled since 2005!



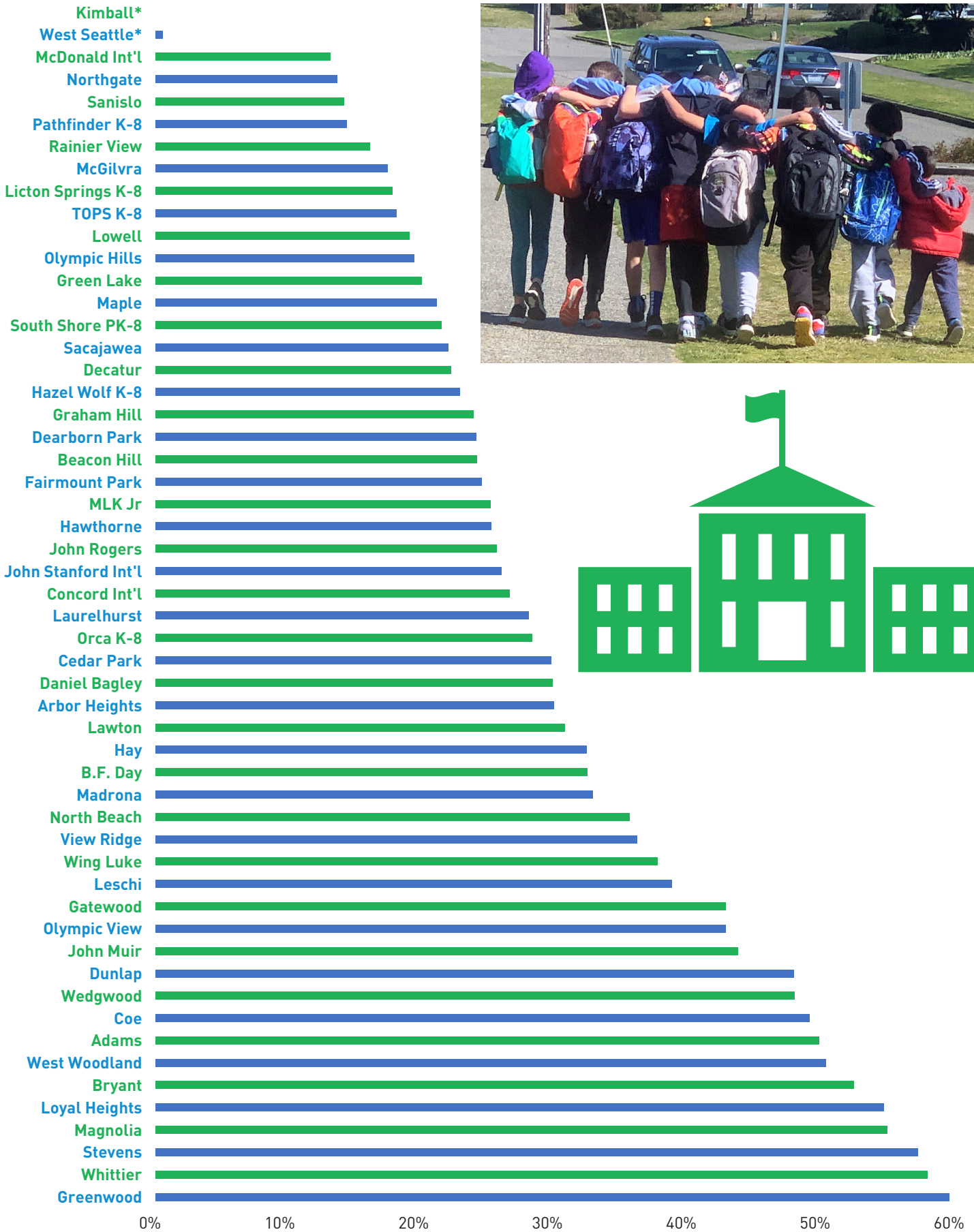
