



Demolition and Repaving East and West 3rd Ave

- Between Stewart & Virginia St:
 - Pour concrete for the sidewalk and curb lane (west curb → center line)
 - Saw cut and demolish the east side's concrete panels
- What does that mean for you?
 - Access to **3rd Avenue between Stewart and Virginia** from the curb to the center line will shift periodically but be restricted from 7pm at night until 7am the next morning


January 19 - 25, 2026



Demolition & Repaving on East 3rd Ave and Manhole Rebuild

- Between Stewart & Virginia St:
 - Shift traffic to the west side of 3rd Ave
 - Demolish and pour concrete for the east side's sidewalk and curbside lane
 - Pour concrete for 2 panels on 3rd Ave (east curb → center line)
 - Rebuilding the Manhole in the center of the Virginia St Intersection (Jan 23-24)
- What does that mean for you?
 - Access to 3rd Avenue between Stewart and Virginia from the curb to the center line will shift periodically but be restricted from 7pm at night until 7am the next morning
 - **During the Virginia Intersection closure (Jan 23-24), one lane northbound will remain open on 3rd Ave from 7pm on Saturday and 7am Monday**


January 26 - February 1, 2026




Demolition and Repaving

- At the Virginia Intersection:
 - Demolish and pour concrete on the south side of Virginia intersection (Jan 30-2/1)
 - Adding temporary striping to guide traffic
- What does that mean for you?
 - **During the Virginia Intersection closure (Jan 23-24), one lane northbound will remain open on 3rd Ave from 7pm on Saturday and 7am Monday. See next slide for bus detours.**
