

Roosevelt and Pinehurst Way NE Paving & Safety Project – 100% Final Design

Background

The roadway has experienced wear and tear, impacting vehicle, pedestrian, and bicycle travel. Resurfacing and repairing the road will help prevent further damage and lower long-term maintenance costs.

Along with **resurfacing the asphalt** for smoother travel, we will be making important infrastructure upgrades, such as:

- fixing the road base
- upgrading curb ramps that meet ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) standards
- improving storm water drainage systems
- sidewalk repairs
- new and upgraded crosswalks
- new protected bike lanes
- new bus stop improvements
- upgrading traffic signal poles

Parking Changes

To maintain and modernize the neighborhood corridor—including upgrades to bike and transit infrastructure—neighbors can also expect **parking changes** on Roosevelt Way and Pinehurst Way NE. Here's what to expect:

- Most on-street parking will be removed on the east side of the street along the Roosevelt Way and Pinehurst Way NE project corridor from NE 92nd St to NE 117th St.
- In a few select spots, parking will be removed on both sides of Roosevelt Way and Pinehurst Way NE. The City is also transitioning the area on NE 113th St near the businesses on Pinehurst Way NE to City-managed one- to two-hour timed parking.

New Green Space Improvements

We are adding two new green space improvements to provide safer turning movements for vehicles, better sightlines, shorter street crossing distances for pedestrians. The areas we'll be adding these improvements are:

- Roosevelt Way NE, Pinehurst Way NE and NE 113th St, on the northwest corner of the intersection.
- Pinehurst Way NE, NE 115th St and 12th Ave NE, on the east side of Pinehurst Way NE. The travel lanes off Pinehurst Ave NE going to 12th Ave NE will now be one-way, southbound only.

Tree Impacts

As part of our sidewalk repair project, approximately 6 trees have been identified for removal adjacent to sidewalks to maintain compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). In accordance with City code, we will plant replacement trees at a 3:1 ratio. The approximately 20 new trees will be planted in existing tree pits and planting strips, as well as in new medians and planting areas within the new Green Space Improvement areas.

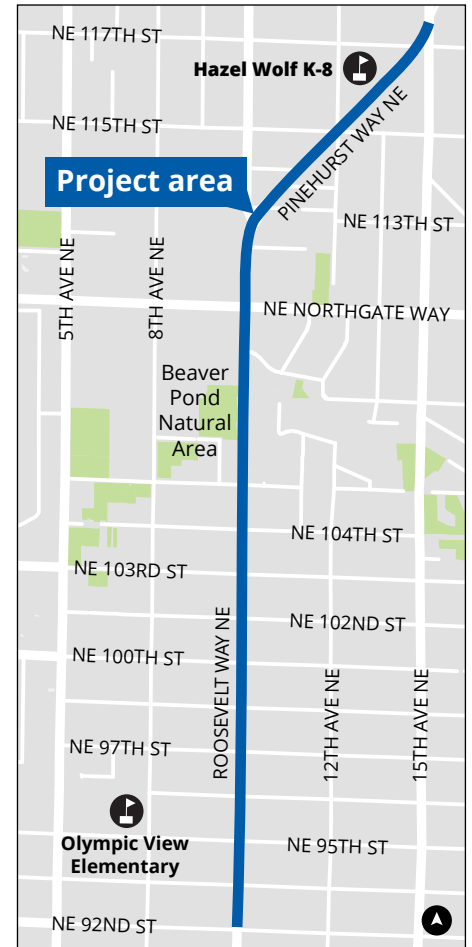
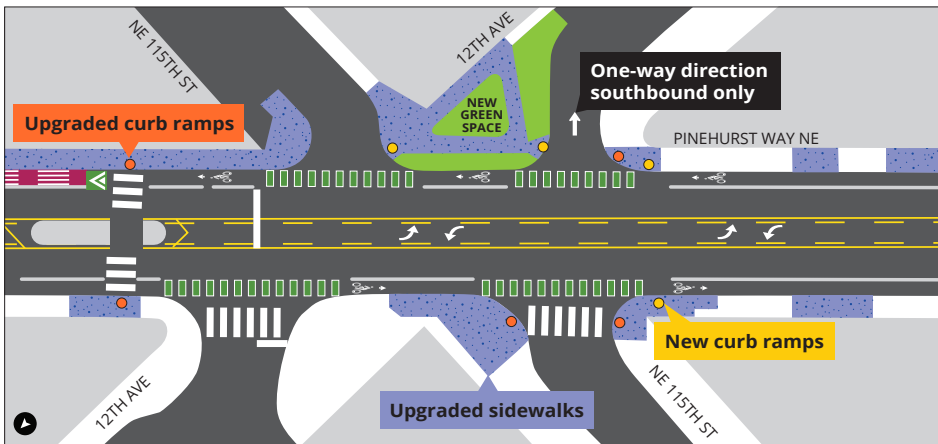
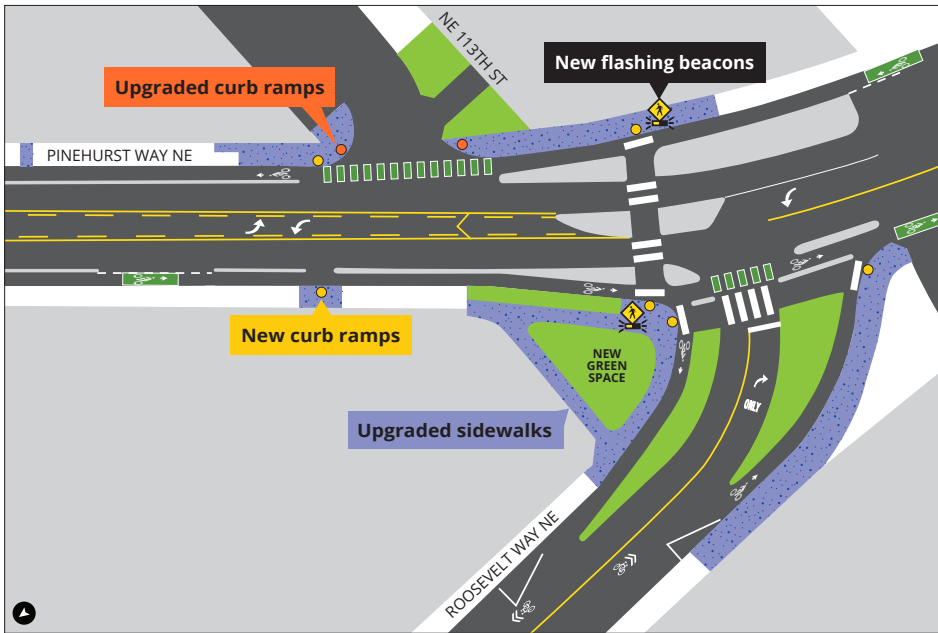
