Notice of Joint Rulemaking

Under the authority of Seattle Municipal Code 22.800, 3.06.040, and 3.32.020 the Department of Construction and Inspections (SDCI) and Seattle Public Utilities (SPU) propose to revise Director's Rule DWW-285 / 12-2026, University of Washington Stormwater Code Adjustment for Minimum Requirement for On-Site Stormwater Management (OSM) and Water Quality Treatment (WQT) in San Juan Drainage Basin. We invite the public's review and input.

The rule update consists of three major changes:

- Allowing the regional facility to serve as a bank for both OSM and Basic WQT since the facility design meets stormwater code requirements for both. The current rule allows only for the bank to be used for OSM.
- Restructuring of sections for clarity and to reduce the need for future revisions when another set of building plans within the basin would apply the bank area to code requirements.
- Updating the map of the San Juan Basin bank area to reflect a change to its boundaries with the removal of Bagley Hall from the basin.
