Air Tons - SPU pays for a minimum of 25 tons per Garbage container disposed with Washington Waste Systems. 'Air tons' refer to the difference between the actual weight of the material and the 25 ton minimum. For example, a container with only 23 tons contains 2 'Air Tons'.
