

Waste Diversion Report Instructions

To access the report, you will need the permit ID number assigned by SDCI. The Waste Diversion Report portal does not require any other login information.

On that web page (screenshot above), enter the permit ID (without CN or DM at the end) and click “Continue”

The next page should load an overview of the permit information – presuming it looks correct and confirms that you have opened the report for the permit you intended, click “Continue” once again.

The next page should look about like the following screenshot, the applicant email address is automatically loaded from SDCI's database. You must enter the estimated project square footage and answer whether an asbestos abatement was performed.

Optionally, you can add contact information for who is responsible for completing the report if it is different from the applicant. Adding another email in the "WDR Contact" section will send reminder emails to that address as well as the applicant's.

To complete a Diversion Record, you will need to identify the material type, diversion method (reuse on site, salvage off-site, recycle – source separated, recycle – commingled, disposal), the quantity of material and the unit of measure (in tons, pounds, cubic yards, or number of items), answer whether the material was taken to the receiving facility by workers at the site or a third party hauler, report the date of the haul, the name of the hauler (if not self-haul) and the receiving facility.

This form allows for text entry or selection of known materials, haulers, and facilities (see WDR List Choices document for options)
