



UPCOMING CONSTRUCTION WORK

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: MAPLE LEAF GATE HOUSE UTILITY WORK FOR 430 PIPELINE PROJECT

Seattle Public Utilities (SPU) contracting crews will perform utility work at the gate house located at Maple Leaf Reservoir Park. Crews will install a hatch and maintenance hole in the grass in front of the gate house to allow utility workers access to the pipeline.

This work is in preparation for the multisite 430 Pipeline Improvement project that will repair portions of the large pipeline that runs four miles from Volunteer Park to Maple Leaf Reservoir in Seattle. The pipeline was built in the early 1900s and is part of the region's drinking water system.

Contracting crews will return to this site periodically over the next year to perform lining work inside of the pipe.

LOCATION OF UTILITY WORK:

Work will take place in or near the grass in front of the gate house at Maple Leaf Reservoir Park. A temporary fence will be installed around the construction site to keep park users and crew safe.

SCHEDULE:

The excavation work to install an access hatch and maintenance hole will **begin in September 2022**. While the pipeline is being cleaned, crews will also work from this site to access the pipeline. Working hours are weekdays from **7 am to 5 pm** with noisy work starting after 8 am.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION:

- Construction noise, dust, dirt, and vibrations.
- Access restrictions for park users around the gate house. A temporary fence will be installed around the construction site to keep park users and crew safe.
- Utility trucks and construction equipment near the work area.
