PROJECT BACKGROUND

SPU operates the North Transfer Station, located in Wallingford. SPU strives to be a good neighbor and maintain air quality standards, including controlling odors.

Since Spring 2023, our team has completed the following:

- Collected warm weather seasonal odor sample in June 2023
- Evaluated new odor complaints, weather data, and current operating conditions, to identify possible improvements
- Modeled site-specific odor patterns and impacts of possible improvements using warm weather odor data, terrain data, discharge velocity, and direct weather observations
- Evaluated select operational improvement solutions for cost and feasibility of implementation based on modeling results
