3. New Business

King County Water System Plan Approval Process

Bob Burns, King County Deputy Director of the Department of Natural Resources and Parks went through the new Water System Plan approval process which has been modified to be more transparent and to include a faster review process.

Operating Board By-Laws Review and Organizational Chart (Attachment 2, 2a) Terri Gregg, Wholesale Contracts Manager gave a quick review of the Operating Board By-Laws and review the OB Organizational Chart with a focus on the rules when and by whom a caucus can be called.

2010 Wholesale Financial True-up – Report and Approval (Attachment 3) Regina Carpenter (SPU) and Laurie Tish (Moss Adams) presented the draft results from the 2010 Wholesale Statements and Independent Accountant's Report on Applying the Agreed upon Procedures (True-up). Ms. Tish reported that Moss Adams did not find anything unusual in the review process. Request was made for any OB member to respond within one week of the presentation for any question to the report. Final report will be completed by July 29th, 2011. The Operating Board voted to approve the draft report by a vote of 6-0.

2012-2014 Rate Proposal Update

Regina Carpenter, SPU Sr. Economist gave a presentation on the June 2nd OB resolution which recommended SPU reconsider the rates and the demand forecast. The presentation included using a less pessimistic demand forecast in employment growth, how the consumption could be impacted by the weather if there were a series of cool/wet summers, and the impacts that the rate study which had to be completed before the final 2010 expenditures were known. Julie Burman, presented on the regional conservation programs (O&M and CIP) and the impacts on rates. More discussion will occur on conservation at the September/October OB meetings. Based on the outcome of the review Seattle's recommendation is to maintain the wholesale rates at the proposed levels.
