• Equivalent Residential Units (ERU)

Regina Carpenter, Sr. Economist SPU gave a review of the definition, the authority and history of what constitutes an ERU. She also addressed the current issues surrounding ERU's such as; fire sprinklers, long service runs, accessory dwelling units and combination fire and domestic services. A SPU recommendation was offered to combine the ¾" and 1" meters to be equivalent to one ERU. The Board requested that they be given time to review the information and have a further discussion on this topic at a future meeting.

• <u>2013 Water System and Capital Facilities Plan</u> (Attachment 2) Joan Kersnar, Drinking Water Planning Manager gave an overview of the 6 and 20 year capital facilities plan within the 2013 Water System Plan. She highlighted the future projects such as; Morse Lake Pumping Plant, overflow dyke improvements, Landsburg passage, HCP, watershed stewardship, regional facilities and the pipeline rehabilitation project. A Board Member requested to make a comment to say "thank you to SPU for doing a remarkable job in regards to the large capital improvement projects that were completed over the years and their low impact to wholesale customers and their ratepayer".

Morse Lake Pumping Plant Project (MLPP Project)

Dave Hilmoe, SPU Drinking Water Director gave a brief update on the MLPP project management plan, scope, schedule and budget. The project manager of the MLPP will come back at a future meeting this year to share more details on the project.
