New Business

Wholesale Financial True-up Proposed Procedures

Regina Carpenter, Sr. Economist and Laurie Tish with Moss Adams presented the proposed 2011 True – Up procedures which are identical to the previous procedures completed for the 2010 Financial True-Up Report. The Operating Board approved the procedures 5-0 with a caveat of a straw dog historical look back on previous true-up numbers.

Financial Reporting

Regina Carpenter, Sr. Economist presented the 2011 year end and the first quarter of 2012 financial reports. The Operating Board liked the format of the presentation and requested the presentations continue a month after the end of each quarter. Next presentation tentatively scheduled for the August 2012 Operating Board meeting.

• Tolt Slide Monitoring and Stabilization

Eugene Mantchev, Transmission Business Area Manager gave an update on the monitoring of the Tolt transmission line slide area. Since the overall monitoring began movement of the slide area has been approximately seven inches. Logging appears to be a factor in the slide but this is a large and complex area. SPU will be looking into acquiring the area from the Hancock Forest Management Group. The Tolt River is moving into the slide area at roughly 3- 4 feet per year and may be contributing to the problem. SPU may construct an eco-friendly stabilization area near the river after learning more this summer. Next steps will include the results of the geo-physics report on the river and a look at possibly installing a de-watering well.
