### New Business

Regina Carpenter (SPU) gave a summary of the 2011 true up results. Highlighted in her hand out were rate base cost pools in the Full and Partial Requirement contracts, the Block contracts and the facility charge cost pool in the Full and Partial contracts. Also given was the request for a straw dog of historical true up information since the beginning of the new contracts. Reviewed and presented was Moss Adams letter to the OB and the results of the Agreed-Upon Procedures for the True-Up. After some discussion and a request to have more time to review the procedures prior to the vote, Byron Murgatroyd moved to approve the procedures with a caveat to review and then reconcile the typo's called out in the draft report. Ron Sheadel seconded the motion as stated and the procedures were approved by a vote of 5-0.

Operations, Planning & Scheduling (OPS)

Tom Fox, Water Resource Manager gave a power point presentation on the current water quality and water supply conditions stating that SPU by-pass Lake Youngs 91% of the time this year during the cyclotella algae bloom, spring refill is complete, storage is good and refills are on target. NOAA predicts we are trending towards an El Nino weather year predictions showing a possible drier than normal summer.

 Terri Gregg, Wholesale Contracts Manager gave a review of the remaining year of the 2012 OB work plan. Request was made to be given an update following the emergency management AWWA conference this year.
