Note: This in-person Operating Board meeting was conducted in conjunction with a tour of the Tolt Watershed. The collective event ran from 9am to 3pm. The business meeting was an abbreviated meeting from 9:30am to 10:40am. After the meeting, the attendees toured the Tolt Treatment Plant (led by Jim Nilson, Paige Igoe & Alex Chen), had lunch at the Vista House near the Tolt Dam, and toured the Tolt Dam (led by Brooke Pennock & Alex Chen).

1. Welcome, Roll Call & Announcements

The Operating Board (OB) Chair, Jeremy Delmar welcomed everyone to the meeting. Roll call was taken. A round of introductions was conducted because the attendees included many wholesale customer staff who do not typically attend Operating Board meetings. Alex Chen provided safety information pertinent to being at the Tolt Treatment Plant.

2. Agenda/Minutes

3. New Business

3a) South Fork Tolt FERC Relicensing Project

Maura Patterson, SPU Drinking Water Planning and Policy Advisor, provide an overview of the project to relicense the South Fork Tolt Dam. The presentation covered the project background, FERC, the project approach, the process and timeline, work performed in 2023, and work planned for 2024.

There were questions and discussion regarding how the tribes will be involved in the process, how decisions are made with the stakeholders, how decisions are documented, the purpose of the various scientific studies, logging on land adjacent to the watershed, the project budget, and clarifying that no operational changes are planned. The wholesale customers requested that SPU let them know when

public comment periods arise. SPU committed to providing that information.

3b) Cedar and Tolt Watershed Bridges

Mike Connelly, SPU's Watershed Engineer, shared information about the bridges that SPU is responsible for in the Cedar and Tolt watersheds. The presentation covered the history of watershed bridges, the current inventory, the bridge inspection program, the rehabilitation & replacement decision model, and next steps for the bridge program.

There were questions and discussion regarding seismic assessments, whether any current bridges have been deemed unnecessary, how decisions are made on whether work is done in-house or contracted out, the condition assessment process, assumptions on bridge lifespans, and who regulates the bridges.
