## 1. Welcome, Introductions & Announcements

The Operating Board (OB) Chair, Jeremy Delmar welcomed everyone to the meeting. Terri Gregg, Seattle Public Utilities (SPU), relayed she is filling in for Kathy Curry, Wholesale Contracts Manager, while she is out on vacation. Terri completed roll call of OB Members and confirmed there was a quorum to begin the meeting.

## 2. Agenda/Minutes

- a) The May 11, 2023 minutes were approved 6-0.
- b) The June 1, 2023 agenda was approved 6-0.

#### 3. New Business

#### 3a) Wholesale Metering

Eugene Mantchev, SPU's Transmission and Metering Program Manager gave an update on SPU's wholesale meter program.

One of the members asked where does the ownership of the assets end for SPU and begin for the customer. Eugene relayed that SPU owns the meter, vault, and all the plumbing appurtenances within the vault. The customer owns from the downstream exterior of the vault. The member also mentioned that she had received a list of District meters, their age, and recent testing results and asked if others could get this information. Terri said to contact her and she would get that information out to anyone that requests it.

## 3b) Water System Cyber Security

Christian Kisky, SPU Senior SCADA Systems Administrator, shared information on SPU's advanced, multilayered security measures to guard against cyber and physical attacks. Following Christian's presentation, the group discussed a few questions and comments.

## 3c) Customer Assistance & Affordability

Leslie Brinson, SPU Senior Policy Advisor shared information on SPU's customer financial assistance programs and policies. There was a general conversation following the presentation with a few questions.

#### 5. Executive Summaries & Other Business

- Water Consumption from Watersheds vs. Rate Studies Alex Chen went over the graphs on
   Attachment 5a relaying that consumption is up and we are in good shape this year for water supply.
- Water Supply Update Alex Chen went over the current water supply and relayed that, with recent
  warm weather, the snow has melted off quickly and the Cedar reservoir is full; however, the Tolt
  reservoir is below normal due to not as much snow fall in the watershed. To keep the Tolt as full as is
  possible, SPU has been pushing more Cedar water to the North and using less Tolt water.
- Update on the Cedar Eastside Supply Line Break SPU determined that the contractor had called One Call as they are required to do; however, it was determined that SPU's pipeline was not correctly shown on the One-Call map such that no locates for the pipeline were called in to SPU. SPU is working to get this problem resolved by getting the map corrected in the known inaccuracy area, along with having the accuracy of mapping of SPU's entire transmission system double-checked to ensure the entire pipeline system is correctly reflected on the One-call map.
