

**Community Comment Card – Public Meeting, June 30, 2016**

Draft Recommendation		Community Comments or Suggestions	
<b>9401 Myers Way S. (immediately south of the JTF)</b> Proposed for future expansion of parking and training areas at the JTF. Within 15 years, the City will need to relocate Arrowhead Gardens Apartments parking use. Other training needs have been identified, such as driver and trench safety.			
<b>9501 Myers Way S. (south of Roxbury Street, north of City Light right of way)</b> Proposed for sale at fair market value. It could be sold through a negotiated sale with a developer that supports community needs (e.g., job creation or mixed-use activities). Could be marketed with the use of a real estate broker to facilitate a sale for such purposes while assuring appropriate financial compensation to the City.			
<b>9600 and 9701 Myers Way S. (south of City Light right of way, east of Myers Way)</b> Complete a negotiated sale with a purchaser who will preserve and enhance the property's natural environment. Examples may include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Land trust foundation that would permit public access for recreation/education.</li> <li>• Adventure park operator that would preserve trees and allow public access.</li> <li>• Commercial developer that would preserve or enhance the natural areas.</li> </ul> If a sale is not completed within two years, the property is proposed to be transferred to the Seattle Parks and Recreation for green space. Parks would consider what level of public access would be suitable through its own processes and budget.
