

FULL BODY IMMERSION VIRTUAL REALITY AT MOTION WORKSHOP

Co-owner and film special effects professional Erik Bakke gives insight into a day-in-the-life of working for at a Seattle creative VR tech business. Motion Workshop, a small motion sensor technology business in Pioneer Square, has developed a Shadow full-body motion-capture system used to live stream a person's body to a digital skeleton for game/film visual effects, VR simulation, sports training, and more.
