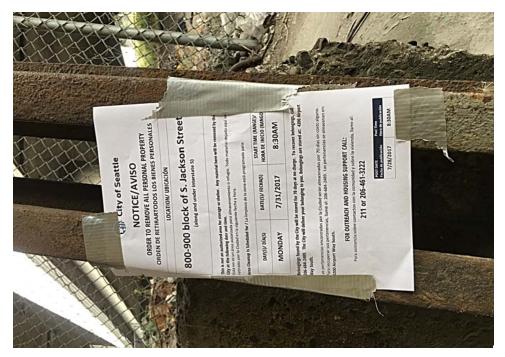


Exhibit B: Sit Posting

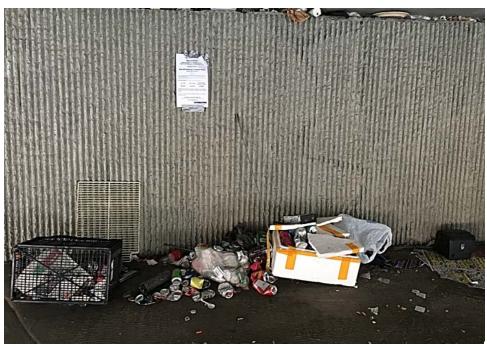




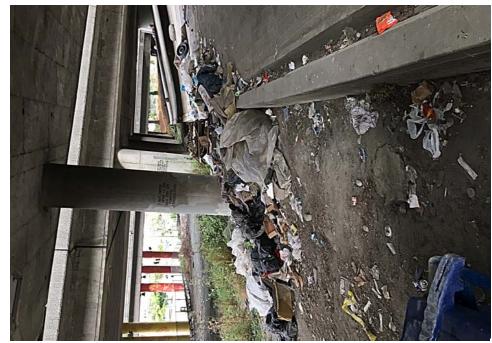
















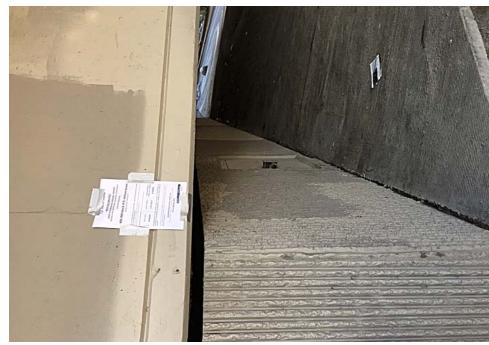






































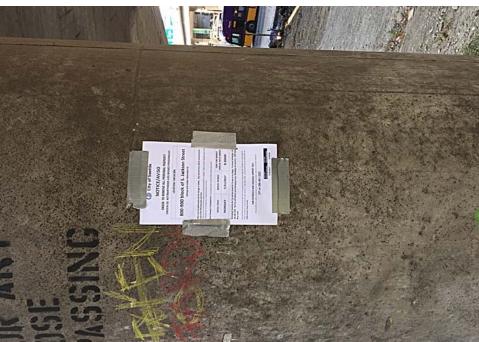
