







#### **INTRO** | PROJECT SUMMARY


Fortson Square is beginning the process of reawakening, honoring Seattle's historic architectural past and reinvigorated future. The proposal regards the restoration of a masonry wall on the prevelent corner, returning the fabric to historical sameness, concious of color, finish, wearing and weathering of the existing and new construction. As a key crossing point from downtown into pioneer square and a major sightline along public sidewalk of 2nd avenue, the exposed brick wall of the Monterey Hotel offers oppertunity to improve the wall's performance and tie previous, historic masonry to the proposed restoration.






