
Our Promise to You

Cherry Hill Campus - Existing Uses





Heart & Vascular Institute

- Region's leading cardiovascular care center.
- Broad range of services and expertise in the most complex conditions.
- Heart disease becomes the leading killer of men by 45 years of age and women by 65 years of age.





Swedish Neuroscience Institute

- Full range of services from sophisticated diagnostics to advanced rehab.
- Neuroscience Institute needs to grow 5 to 10 percent per year for the next 5 to 10 years to meet growing patient demand.
- The Swedish Neuroscience Institute will be one of the top five centers in the country.





Swedish Multiple Sclerosis Center

- One of the largest and most comprehensive centers for multiple sclerosis care in the region and in the US.
- Provided more than 10,000
 patient care visits in 2012, a

 48% increase from 2011.
- We are committed to care for all MS patients regardless of their ability to pay.





Post Acute Care

- In-patient rehab, skilled nursing, long-term acute care and residential care are important components for helping patients return to the highest level of function and independence.
- Ideal for patients who want to be close to specialized medical facilities at the Cherry Hill Campus.





Primary Care

- Nearly 450,000 people in Washington State will be newly covered by insurance due to the Affordable Care Act.
- 150,000 of those will be in King County.
- Swedish **residency program** it is the **largest in nation**.
- Primary care is important to our neighbors.








Partnerships are Critical
