Project Description	This project will complete the redevelopment of Little Brook Park beginning with the design developed by community members led by Lake City Collective. This project will begin with the design proposed for the redevelopment and includes an updated play area, picnic tables and seating, a covered gathering area, a creek boardwalk, a community garden, and a restroom.
Schedule	Planning: Summer 2023 Design: Fall 2023-Fall 2024 Construction: Spring 2025








LITTLE BROOK PARK: SD SITE PLAN (SUMMER 2021)




