The Seattle Center to Waterfront Greenway will build an important connection between the Thomas Street Overpass and Seattle Center providing a safer, more comfortable way to walk and bike between some of Seattle's most popular destinations.

In coordination with the opening of the new arena at Seattle Center, currently mid-2021, this project will construct an all ages and abilities walking and biking connection between the Thomas St Overpass and the Seattle Center via Thomas St and Republican St. This project will connect the neighborhood greenway with the future 1st Ave N and Queen Anne Ave N protected bike lanes that will be constructed in association with the new arena at Seattle Center.
