

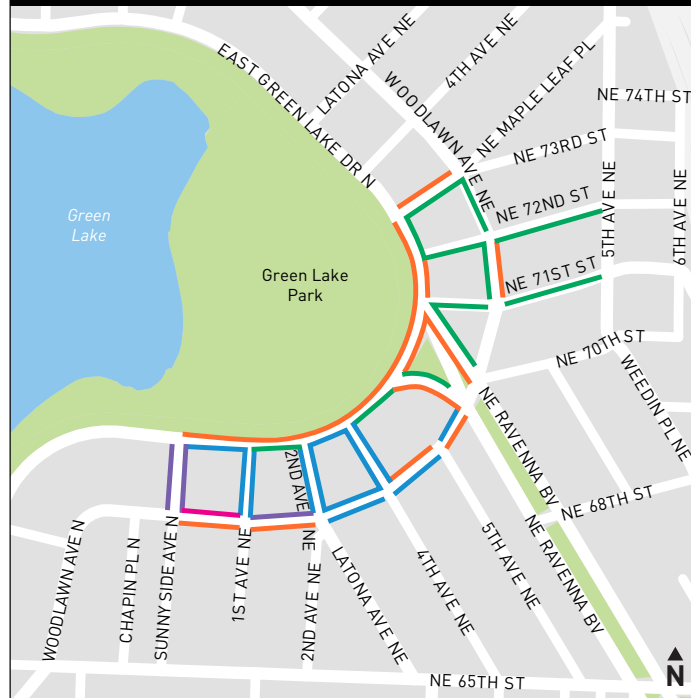

The Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) would like to correct an error on the postcard that was mailed the week of July 10th. SDOT is not planning to add paid parking on Woodlawn Ave NE from Sunnyside Ave N to 2nd Ave NE. We apologize for the confusion. Below is where SDOT intends to expand existing paid parking in Fall 2023:

- 1st Ave NE from Woodlawn Ave NE to E Green Lake Dr N (east and west side)
- 2nd Ave NE from Woodlawn Ave NE to E Green Lake Dr N (east and west side)
- 4th Ave NE from Woodlawn Ave NE to E Green Lake Dr N (east and west side)
- Woodlawn Ave NE from Latona Ave NE to 4th Ave NE (north and south side)
- Woodlawn Ave NE from 4th Ave NE to 5th Ave NE (south side only)
- Woodlawn Ave NE from 5th Ave NE to NE Ravenna Blvd (north side only)
