

## OVERVIEW

The City of Seattle is still in a period of experiencing a high volume of construction applications for both private and public projects. Right now, Traffic Control Plan (TCP) reviews have extended beyond typical timelines, which is directly impacting timelines for ROW Management permits. This is a temporary impact as we work internally to align resources and streamline processes. For now, these timelines can be expected, and may vary based on the complexity of the project.
