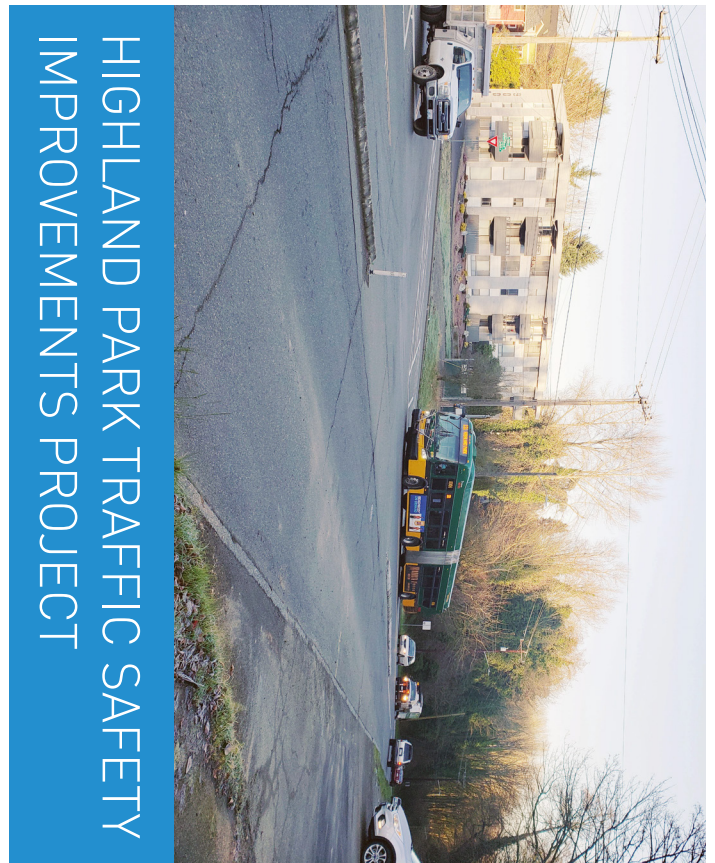

# HIGHLAND PARK TRAFFIC SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

## New traffic signal, protected bike lane, curb bulbs

### OVERVIEW

Highland Park Way SW is a major north-south route in West Seattle, providing access to SR 99, SR 509, I-5, and the Duwamish Trail. The intersection at SW Holden St serves more than 22,000 drivers, transit riders, pedestrians and bicyclists daily.

### WHY IMPROVEMENTS ARE NEEDED

The Highland Park Way SW and SW Holden St intersection has been the site of several accidents and safety issues due to poor sight distances, high speeds, travel lane confusion, and a lack of pedestrian facilities.

### IMPROVEMENTS BEING CONSIDERED

We are currently at the 10% design phase of this project. Proposed improvements include:

- A fully signalized intersection at Highland Park Way SW and SW Holden St
- Protected bike lane between SW Holden St and W Marginal Way
- Several additional safety improvements throughout the neighborhood

### SHARE YOUR INPUT

We are developing a concept for the intersection and would like your input before we begin the design process. SDOT staff will be available to share data and concepts, answer questions, and collect your input at an upcoming open house.
